Minutes of Budget Meetings

January 1-1944 to December 31-1944

January 6, 1944.

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at 3:00 o'clock. All members were present.

The following transfer of 1943-44 appropriations was approved by the Commission:

Public Service Commission

Motor Transport Division

Salaries of Inspectors \$909.27 - To "Other Supplies (License Plates)".

Freight Express & Deliveries \$70.00 - To "Repairs".

The following allotments were made from the 1943-44 Civil Contingent Fund:

Commission on State House and Grounds \$240.00 for "Repairs."
State Treasurer's Office \$1,110.00 for "Clerical Help"
Comptroller General's Office \$145.82 for "County Treasurers Salaries."

Mr. Christie Benet, State Chairman of the War Finance Committee, submitted a report showing a balance of \$140.69 of the \$750.00 fund supplied to the War Finance Committee to assist in defraying expenses of the Committee.

The Commission took no action on request from H. M. Pace, Chairman of the State Planning Board, that an appropriation of \$12,000.00 be recommended to negotiate a survey of South Carolina ground water resources.

A request from the State Board of Health that \$8,000.00 be supplied to carry on the Cancer Control Program in the present fiscal year was refused, on the grounds that this should be handled as a deficiency appropriation.

The Commission then adjourned.
