### DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA

October 24, 2003

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The regular monthly meeting of the Department of Transportation Commission was held in the fifth floor auditorium of the Headquarters Building in Columbia, South Carolina at 9:00 a.m. on October 24, 2003. In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, the news media was advised in writing of the time, date and place of this meeting.

SECTION 1: On motion of Commissioner Harrell, seconded by Commissioner Mack, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the September 29, 2003 Commission Minutes; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of surplus right of way property, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise and select a consulting firm to provide environmental studies and engineering design services for the proposed Arkwright Connector project, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise and select a consulting firm for the purpose of assisting the Department in developing the RFP technical package for the demolition of the existing bridges over the Cooper River, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise and select engineering/environmental firm to provide natural stream design services for the restoration of approximately 15,000 linear feet of impacted piedmont stream in Newberry County, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department regarding professional engineering services for several bridges in various counties, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: On motion of Commissioner Harrell, seconded by Commissioner Truluck, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the RISE program project funding list as shown in detail in the Appendix, and further that upon approval of project lists submitted by individual Commissioners, SCDOT staff is directed to proceed with the development of the projects.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending existing construction contracts to include additional work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the extension of a contract beyond the contract limits as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in removing roads from the State Highway System, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in removing a road, by Court Order, from the State Highway System, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion correction the description of a section of State Highway previously added to the State Highway System, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in adding sections of roads to the State Highway System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the highway letting of September 9, 2003, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 15: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning a project in the highway letting of October 14, 2003, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 16: On motion of Commissioner Mack, seconded by Commissioner Harrell, the Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Chairman and the Executive Director to meet with representatives of the Department of Public Safety to discuss methods of using state troopers to improve the enforcement of work zone speed limits to enhance the safety of the workers in these areas. The motion also authorizes the Department to request that the forty-six county sheriff's departments encourage their personnel to also enforce work zones laws.

SECTION 17: On motion of Commissioner Truluck, seconded by Commissioner Harrell, the Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the staff to conduct the design engineering work required to determine the cost of the Briggs-Delaine-Pearson Connector.

SECTION 18: On motion of Commissioner Mack, seconded by Commissioner Hardee, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the Mass Transit Funding Distribution program, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 19: On motion Commissioner Truluck, seconded by Commissioner Mack, the Commission passed a motion to postpone decisions on the outdoor advertising vegetation maintenance program and requested the staff to provide the Commission with more information regarding cost estimates for the program. Commissioner Hardee excused himself from the room during this discussion and did not vote on this motion.

SECTION 20: On motion of Commissioner Mack, seconded by Commissioner Hardee, the Commission unanimously passed a motion adopting the Enhancement Program as presented by the Department and shown in detail in the Appendix. Commissioner Mack requested the program be implemented in 2004.

SECTION 21: There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 11:50 a.m.

## **Appendix**

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1. File 26.836 / US Route 501 / Horry County

During construction of improvements on U.S. Route 501, under File 26.836, in Horry County, in Conway Township, the Department acquired right of way, by Title to Real Estate, from Folger Leasing Company dated February 27, 1998.

In order to settle a difficult acquisition case, the Department agreed to convey a small piece of surplus property to the Grantee as partial payment for new right of way needed. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.357 of an acre of land to Folger Leasing Company was executed on September 12, 2003.

2. File 30.625 / SC Route 72 & Road S-542 / Laurens County

During construction of improvements on Road S-542, under File 30.625 in Laurens County, near the City of Clinton, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-542, by Dedication dated November 30, 1965.

A request was received from the District Two office, asking the Department to convey a small piece of surplus right of way to the Grantee which will allow them to expand their building. The Grantee has agreed to bear all construction expenses for relocating Road S-542 and improve the intersection to the Department's benefit. In turn, the Department will convey a small parcel of surplus right of way in which it only has dedicated interest. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.047 of an acre of land to Bishop Tire Co. was executed on September 11, 2003.

3. File 39.674 / SC Route 93 & US 123 / Pickens County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 93, under File 39.674 in Pickens County, near the City of Clemson, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 93, by Title to Real Estate (Tract 27) from Grace C. Manley dated November 21, 2001 and by Condemnations (Tracts 24 & 26) from Grace C. Manley dated May 15, 2000.

A request was received from the City of Clemson asking the Department to sell the uneconomic remainders of tracts 24, 26, and 27 to use as a bike trail. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.45 of an acre of land to City of Clemson was executed on September 8, 2003 in consideration of \$10,000.00.

4. File 30.648 / 30.650 / S-47 / S-81 / Laurens County

During construction of improvements on Road S-47/S-81, under File 30.648/30.650 in Laurens County, near the Town of Ware Shoals, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-81, by Condemnation from Riegel Power Corporation dated July 25, 1990 and From Mrs. Bertha C. Howell by Title to Real Estate dated March 6, 1989.

The Laurens County Water and Sewer Commission (LCWSC) and the Town of Ware Shoals are constructing a joint sewer service project to provide sewer service to a local school. To facilitate this project, LCWSC has requested a small parcel of land to construct two sewer lift stations. This irregular shaped surplus parcel has a very low topography and has little if any value. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.45 of an acre of land to Laurens County Water and Sewer Commission was executed on September 2, 2003 in consideration of \$1,000.00.

5. File 32.870 / 40.251 / Fernandina Road / Lexington / Richland County

During construction of improvements on Fernandina Road, under File 32.870 in Lexington County, near St. Andrews, the Department acquired right of way for Fernandina Road, by Condemnation from Columbia Outdoor Advertising, Inc. dated August 4, 1997.

The Department condemned the subject parcel for construction and for slopes. The Condemnee refused to settle. A revision was made on the plans so that the property acquired under the condemnation was now surplus to the Department's needs. Legal asked that this office provide a quitclaim deed to clear the Condemnee's title with exception of a 30'x 30' triangle, which will be retained. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.09 of an acre of land to Columbia Outdoor Advertising, Inc. was executed on September 30, 2003.

6. File 23.243A / Road S-136 Relocation (S. Buncombe Road) / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on Road S-136 (South Buncombe Road), under File 23.483A in Greenville County, near the City of Greer, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-136 by Right of Way Easement from the Estate of Frank M. Henderson, dated April 26, 1961.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to convey a small parcel of surplus property. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if the subject parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to the Departments needs. Since the Department acquired the subject parcel by Right of Way Easement and the Grantees are the Successors in Title, it is appropriate to convey the subject parcel gratis. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.34 of an acre of land to Lewis Keith Smith Revocable Trust and Eloise H. Smith Revocable Trust was executed on September 30, 2003.



7. File 23.243A / Road S-136 Relocation (S. Buncombe Road) / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on Road S-136 (South Buncombe Road), under File 23.483A in Greenville County, near the City of Greer, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-136 by Right of Way Easement from (Mrs.) Eloise H. Smith by Right of Way Easement dated April 4, 1961.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to convey a small parcel of surplus property. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if the subject parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to the Department's needs. Research has shown that the Department acquired the subject right of way by easement and at no cost from the requestor in 1961, thus it is appropriate that the Department not receive payment for the right of way. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.05 of an acre of land to Eloise H. Smith Revocable Trust was executed on September 30, 2003.

8. File 2245.580 / SC Route 41 / Georgetown / Williamsburg County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 41 under File 45.245 in Williamsburg County, near the Town of Andrews, the Department acquired right of way by Deed to Right of Way from M.C. Watford dated November 5, 1947 at no cost to the Department.

While negotiating to settle a difficult acquisition case, the Department agreed to convey a small surplus parcel that was originally acquired gratis from the Grantee's family in exchange for the new right of way needed for the Relocation of SC 41. By this action, the Department will also remove several existing encroachments from its right of way. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.06 of an acre of land to Robert C. Watford was executed on October 6, 2003.

9. File 40.648A / I-26/ US Rte 176 / Richland County

During construction of improvements on I-26 Frontage Road, under File 40.468A in Richland County, near the City of Columbia, the Department acquired right of way for I-26 Frontage Road, by Condemnation from The Harbison Group, A SC General Partnership dated January 30, 2001.

While negotiating to settle a difficult acquisition case, the Department agreed to convey a small uneconomic remainder to the Grantee in exchange for the new right of way needed for the project. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.20 of an acre of land to Bluebird Investors was executed on October 6, 2003.

**REQUEST FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED**  
**ARKWRIGHT CONNECTOR PROJECT IN**  
**SPARTANBURG COUNTY**

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise and select a consulting firm for the purpose of providing environmental studies and engineering design services for the proposed Arkwright Connector project (a new location roadway) in Spartanburg.

Based on current and projected workloads, the Department does not have sufficient staff to proceed with these projects. The engineering phase of the project will be funded through Congressional Earmarks.

**REQUEST FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR  
DEMOLITION OF COOPER RIVER BRIDGES**

The Department plans to develop the Cooper River Bridges Demolition Project as a design-demolish (similar to design-build) project. It is anticipated that the demolition will include a variety of demolition methods including both mechanical and explosive techniques. The Department lacks expertise in the demolition methods, debris removal, and clean-up techniques required for very large structures. Therefore, the Department requests Commission approval to advertise and select a consulting firm for the purpose of assisting the Department in developing the RFP Technical Package for the demolition of the existing bridges over the Cooper River.

## **Request for Consultants to Provide Natural Stream Design Services for the Establishment of a Piedmont Stream Mitigation Bank**

To expedite project development by providing compensatory mitigation for impacts to piedmont streams, the Department requests Commission approval to advertise, select, and negotiate with engineering and/or environmental firms to provide natural stream design services for the restoration of approximately 15,000 linear feet of impacted piedmont stream in Newberry County. The cost for the design, construction, and construction management will be approximately \$1,500,000 dollars that will be funded with federal and state funds. A fund was established in 2002 to provide for these services.

**REQUEST FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR:**

**SEVERAL BRIDGES IN VARIOUS COUNTIES**

These projects will be funded through Bridge Replacement Program.

- 1] US 76/US 378: Bridge over Wateree River in Richland/Sumter Counties
- 2] US 176: Bridge over Broad River in Richland County
- 3] US 21: Bridge over Catawba River in York County
- 4] US 378: Bridge over Great Pee Dee River in Marion/Horry Counties
- 5] US 378: Bridges over Little Pee Dee River & Swamp in Marion/Horry Counties
- 6] US 701: Bridges over Yauhannah Lake, Great Pee Dee & Pee Dee Overflow

These services are needed to allow design staff to complete current projects and to have projects ready to obligate for letting in anticipation of receiving additional Bridge Replacement Funds in FY04 and FY05.

October 2003

Staff requests Commission approval of the RISE program projects and funding as indicated on the attached spreadsheets. Based on the projects requested and the match ratios anticipated, the Department's 15 million dollar program will generate a match of approximately 10.5 million dollars. This will result in a RISE program of almost 25.5 million dollars.

Additional information relative to project descriptions can be provided as needed.
