An open letter to the Honorable Nikki Haley  
 Governor of South Carolina  
 Columbia, SC

Governor Haley,

My heart goes out to my native state of South Carolina and to the families of the victims of the recent massacre in Charleston, SC. As a native son of South Carolina I was born in Orangeburg, SC. As one of the first blacks to graduate from [REDACTED] High School and also one of the first blacks to graduate from [REDACTED] University, your [REDACTED], I have witnessed racial attitudes and its politics up close throughout my life. My sophomore year at [REDACTED] my dorm room was actually bombed.

I have a long held view that symbols matter which I said previously at Clemson University to an audience discussing Clemson's past where I was invited by Clemson to participate. During my early years at Clemson, instead of the American Flag being used during the flag ceremony at football games, before you attended Clemson, it was a gigantic confederate flag that was used. Through meetings with the visionary president of Clemson, R.C. Edwards, we were able to have that changed to the American Flag. As a result, black students felt less threatened; there were fewer fights and no significant racial incidences. Symbols matter.

One sore spot I continue to have as I have done research for my book is the fact that Ben Tillman remains a prominent figure on university campuses throughout South Carolina and in the state capital. If you look at history, one could say that Ben Tillman was one of the most significant contributors to a very dark history against black people as the "Edgefield Plan" was implemented for its sole purpose of keeping black men from



voting. There are buildings named for Tillman on many South Carolina University Campuses.

I ask that leaders in South Carolina have the vision to realize that symbols matter and as an example, keep the name of Ben Tillman and other divisive persons in such a positive and prominent places is short sighted and helps create division. To have such characters held in high esteem continues to confirm in the eyes of the nation, South Carolina's insensitivity toward it's racial past.

The same goes for the confederate flag. At some point through either generational change or the change of demographics in the state of South Carolina, that flag will eventually come down but it would be great for a courageous South Carolina leader to come forward and take the initiative and remove that flag from such a prominent place because, symbols matter. I think you have displayed great courage with your stance on taking down the Confederate Battle Flag. I hope that other leaders in South Carolina will follow your lead.
