Dear Governor Haley:

Enclosed you will find the latest monthly export report for your state from the Export-Import Bank of the United States (EXIM).

In September, EXIM financed \$1,643,654.84 in exports from your state as shown in the attached report.

October is Manufacturing Month and EXIM stands ready to work with manufacturers in your region to export more of their American goods and services. Manufacturing supports more than 18.5 million U.S. jobs and makes up nearly 12% of our country's gross domestic product. EXIM works directly with manufacturing exporters and the thousands of small manufacturers in their supply chains to ensure American companies can compete globally on a level playing field.

Unfortunately, the lack of a quorum on EXIM's Board of Directors continues to limit its ability to finance medium- and long-term exports over \$10 million and impacting thousands of jobs from coast to coast. Many of these larger financing deals support thousands of small businesses and other suppliers.

This month, EXIM is transitioning to the electronic delivery of our export reports. This will be the last hard copy report delivered to your office. Multiple members of your staff should have also received an electronic version of this report, and will receive electronic versions going forward.
