#### Description/Significant Features:

The historic structure, located northeast of the cemetery, has been heavily modified since its construction, but based on core stylistic elements and the use of Type 6 Cut Nails (1810-1847) throughout the central area of the structure, it likely dates to the first half of the nineteenth century. Based on observations made during fieldwork, the cabin dates to c.1830. Due to its age and proximity to the cemetery, it is likely associated with the Jefferies family or other community members interred at the Jeffries cemetery.

Replacement roof, siding, bricks to chimney.

### **Historical Information**

Historical Information:

Historical research was unable to confirm the original use or exact construction date of the historic structure located on the Gilkey Creek Tract. However, field observations suggest that the cabin was originally constructed c. 1830, including the use the Type 6 Cut Nails in the core areas of the original structure. Based on the date ranges of the interments at the Jeffries cemetery the structure and the cemetery are likely contemporaneous. Additionally, its proximity to the cemetery suggests that it is likely associated with the Jefferies Family or other community members interred at the cemetery.
