



## SC FLOOD RELIEF FUND REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

### Overview

In the wake of the destruction caused by massive flooding throughout South Carolina, Central Carolina Community Foundation has established the [South Carolina Flood Relief Fund](#) to support nonprofit organizations providing relief and recovery assistances in the eleven counties served by our Foundation.

### Purpose of the Fund

Grants will fund relief and recovery assistance programs provided by nonprofit organizations in the Community Foundation's service area. Organizations may request up to \$25,000.

The proposal should:

- Describe the impacted area and the relief and recovery efforts/programs your organization will provide
- Detail the anticipated impact of the proposal including, but not limited to:
  - Geographic areas served
  - Number of people served
  - Additional dollars that will be contributed (leveraged) using this grant

### What Will Not Be Funded

- Projects not associated with relief and recovery efforts for the impacted region
- Routine operating expenses of the organization
- Fundraising projects
- Endowment development or capital campaigns
- Sponsorships

### Eligible Geographic Areas

Applications will be accepted from organizations providing relief and recovery efforts across South Carolina.

- Preference will be given to FEMA declared disaster areas in South Carolina as of October 2015

### Application Requirements

An organization must:

- Be classified by the Internal Revenue Service as a tax-exempt, 501(c)(3), nonprofit entity or must make use of a fiscal agent that has a 501(c)(3) designation. Be based within or serve one of the counties named above
- Complete an online application
- Provide a detailed project budget

### Additional Notes

- An organization may request up to \$25,000.
- Central Carolina Community Foundation intends to release 100% of funds awarded to each successful applicant at the beginning of the project period.

**Review Process**

The review committee will consist of members of the Community Foundation Board of Trustees and a Advisory Committee made up of community members

**Timeline**

Round One:

- Monday, November 2—Request for Proposals
- Friday, December 4—Proposals due by 6:00 p.m.
- Grant awards announced in early January.
