David,

The Governor has met with Representative Putnam on 4492 and 4546. In that meeting, she stated she is ok with the bills as long as DSS oks them, and they do.

H.4262 essentially does three things:

- 1 – Increases training requirements for family childcare homes from 2 hours to 10 hours a year
- 2 – Codifies current Department practice of doing a background check on anyone over the age of 15 who moves into the home after registration
- 3 – Gives DSS greater ability to consider a home's past history with the Department in evaluating renewals of registration

DSS supports H.4262.
