According to phone records on the night of the Emanuel shootings, Gov. Haley talked several times with SLED Chief Mark Keel, and on the following morning Keel updated her several more times.

The first person other than Keel that Haley spoke with that morning was Adjutant General Livingston in a 7 a.m. call. What was the purpose of that Phone call? Was she just trying to reach out to her husband, or was she mindful of the outbreaks of violence in Ferguson, MO and Baltimore and alerting the National Guard to be on standby or calling on the Guard to prepare a unit in the event it was needed.
