**DID YOU KNOW?** As colors fade and leaves fall, the American Beech will still stand out in the rich bottomlands of the forest among evergreen trees and shrubs. Beech leaves persist through the winter, giving lighter tan accents to the darker landscape. In spring the slender, pointed buds will open as the old leaves are shed. The gray bark of the American Beech stays smooth regardless of the tree's age.
