SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of March 20, 1997 copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department for quitclaim deeds, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department for sale of surplus Right of Way Property - land, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

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## SURPLUS RIGHT OF WAY PROPERTY - LAND

1. File 13.541 - SC Route 151 - Clarendon County

The Department acquired right of way for construction of Road S-346 in Clarendon County, under File 13.360, by Condemnation Notice dated June 15, 1959 from Ridgeview Farms.

At the request of an adjoining owner to acquire a portion of an abandoned Road S-345, it was decided by our Engineering Sections that this portion of the old roadbed was no longer needed and could be relinquished to the adjoining owner. Therefore, a quitclaim deed conveying approximately 0.52 of an acre of land to DeWitt Development Enterprises, LLC, was executed on February 26, 1997, for consideration of \$300.00.

2. File 16.448 - U. S. Route 401 - Darlington County

During acquisition of right of way for construction of Route I-20, under File 16.448, the Department acquired temporary right of way for a detour road from Reverend J. M. Dowling by Condemnation Notice dated March 5, 1968.

At the request of an adjoining owner to acquire this temporary right of way, which was used as a detour road during construction of Route I-20, it was researched and determined that this right of way should have been previously returned to the adjoining owner. Therefore, a gratis quitclaim deed, in consideration of control of access, conveying approximately 0.23 of an acre of land to Victory Industries, Inc. was executed on March 26, 1997.

3. File 42.125A - U. S. Route 221 - Spartanburg County

The Department acquired right of way for construction of improvements along U. S. Route 221 in Spartanburg County, under File 42.125A, by Title to Real Estate dated July 19, 1988 from Grace P. Hollman.

The original owner requested to re-acquire a portion of the right of way along U. S. Route 221 in Spartanburg County that the Department purchased in 1988 in lieu of obtaining construction sloping permission. After being researched it was determined that this 45-foot right of way could be reduced to a 40-foot right of way and the 5 foot strip could be relinquished. Therefore, a gratis quitclaim deed conveying approximately 0.01 of an acre of land to Grace Hollman was executed on March 31, 1997.

4. File 45.408 - Road S-469 - Williamsburg County

During acquisition of right of way for construction of Road S-469, under File 45.408, the Department acquired right of way from H. W. Haselden by Right of Way Easement dated January 26, 1967, Mary H. McAlister by Right of Way Easement dated January 26, 1967, and B. W. Stroud by Right of Way Easement dated March 10, 1967.

At the request of Williamsburg County, a portion of Road S-469 was removed from the State Highway System by Commission Minutes dated May 9, 1995, in order to accommodate a proposed expansion at the Tupperware facility near the Town of Hemingway. The Officials of Williamsburg County requested a deed from the Department, so they could convey this abandoned roadbed to Tupperware to assist with their large expansion. Therefore, a gratis quitclaim deed conveying approximately 4.0 acres of land to the County of Williamsburg was executed on April 3, 1997.

This matter is reported to the Commission in accordance with the requirements of Code Section 57-5-340.

EXTENSION OF CONTRACT BEYOND CONTRACT LIMITS

It is recommended the Commission approve the extension of the following contract beyond the contract limits as follows:

Beaufort County:

Contract of Rea Construction Company - File No. 4756.102 - extended to include milling, resurfacing with asphalt concrete surfacing and pavement markings (paint & thermoplastic) of 1.75 miles on US 278 from SC 170 interchange easterly.

Estimated Cost of Extension

This extension is being requested in order to take advantage of lower unit prices available in this contract as opposed to other contracts currently available for extension in Beaufort County.
