Please review AS soon AS possible because I AM scheduled to max out December 31, 2014 • When I walk out these gates I WANT All this behind me with my reputation redeemed.

Thank you in advance for your time. May Our Creator's Peace Always Be Upon You!
Your silence for two weeks after receiving the legal documents that I've sent you on September 15, 2014, leads me to believe you are investigating the legal documents that I sent you regarding the perjured testimony that lead to my incarceration.

Enclosed is a letter to Governor Nikki Randawa Haley. I had formerly requested that you report your findings to Governor Haley and ask for me a pardon pursuant to the perjured testimony.

Please give her: (The Governor does not always receive inmate letters)
(1) The enclosed letter (2) "a copy of the legal documents I sent you" and
(3) a request to give me a pardon and/or exonerate me based on the perjured testimony.

Mr Keel, I'm begging you for your sincere interest and compassion at helping me get this justice in my case.

I've also voluntarily Relinquished the right to sue for false imprisonment in the event I ~~am~~ exonerated by Governor Nikki Randawa Haley.
