Our 3rd district appointee was an interim and was drawn out of the 3rd district so she no longer qualifies and must come off the board. The 7th district seat is vacant of course because it is brand new.

Without any confirmed appointments, the nursing board is composed of 2 At-large public members and 1 nurse representing the 2nd district, and 8 empty seats.
