Subject: RFI regarding private initiatives for interim storage services

David,

We wanted to let you know that on Thursday, October 27, 2016, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) will be publishing a request for information (RFI) in the Federal Register regarding private initiatives (PI) for making consolidated interim storage facility services available to DOE for spent nuclear fuel (SNF) storage.

The RFI is intended to gather input on the role of PIs for private consolidated interim storage facilities services as part of an integrated waste management system. Since the Administration’s Strategy for the Management and Disposal of Used Nuclear Fuel and High-Level Radioactive Waste was issued, PIs for interim storage facilities (ISF) that could provide DOE or utilities with consolidated SNF interim storage services are in various stages of development. DOE believes that potential host/neighboring communities, potential ISF operators and existing nuclear waste facility operators, among others, may be interested in responding to this RFI.
