- WHEREAS,** open communication, mutual respect, sincere understanding, and unilateral cooperation play a vital role in the promotion of peace and goodwill among all people and between all nations; and
- WHEREAS,** affirming our commitment to interfaith harmony, religious liberty, and tolerance for diverse traditions and beliefs contributes to our continued strength and prosperity; and
- WHEREAS,** as a statewide partnership of ten different religious groups that first met on February 10, 2011, the Interfaith Partners of South Carolina has partnered with the Charter for Compassion to build a statewide network of Compassionate Communities within the Palmetto State's Interfaith community which transcends religious, ideological, and national differences.
