

## Pasture and Range Risk Management Meeting to Be Held

The Agricultural Risk Protection Act of 2000 outlined as a top priority the implementation of a pilot project for a pasture and range risk management program. USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) was required to create a risk management program for pasture and rangeland. During the fall last year listening sessions were held throughout the United States to gather information on the perils and risk management needs of pasture and rangeland producers.

Using the input gathered from these sessions, AgriLogic has come up with risk management concepts for covering forage loss. The researchers at RMA and AgriLogic believe it is imperative to gather more input from producers on these proposed program concepts, so that they can be designed specifically for the needs of producers of pastures and rangeland.

This is your opportunity to let your voice be heard, and outcomes of this project may result in government programs designed to help producers in times of need.

## Entire State of South Carolina Eligible for USDA Emergency Farm Loans

Kenneth Rentiers, Jr., State Executive Director of the USDA Farm Service Agency, recently announced that the entire State of South Carolina is eligible for USDA emergency farm loans due to losses caused by drought that occurred last year.

"This assistance will help farmers in South Carolina recover from drought loss," said USDA Secretary Ann M. Veneman.

The entire State of South Carolina was named as a primary disaster area on March 1, 2002.

This designation makes all qualified farm operators in primary and contiguous disaster counties eligible for low-interest EM loans from the Farm Service Agency, provided eligibility requirements are met. Farmers in eligible counties have eight months from the date of this declaration to apply for the loans to help cover part of their actual losses. FSA will consider each loan application on its own merits, taking into account the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

FSA has a variety of programs available, in addition to the emergency loan program, to help eligible farmers recover from adversity. Interested farmers may contact their local FSA offices for further information on eligibility requirements and application procedures.

She too was excited about the continued prosperity of the festivals and was doing great business when I stopped to speak to her.
