Charleston Consortium Committees

Administration (L.S. Flaum, MUSC, Chmn.) Last meeting 11/19. The committee is working out arrangements for joint purchase of nursing and infirmary supplies through the Medical University. There is also a possibility that The Citadel Print Shop might be able to do work for other consortium institutions. Next meeting: January 26.

Computer (M.C. Miller, III, MUSC, Chmn.) Last meeting 12/15. There was some discussion of cooperation on student exchange in Computer Science courses. The committee was also brought up to date on the proposed cooperative arrangement for computer service by the Medical University for the College of Charleston. Next meeting: January, unscheduled.

Faculty-Student Exchange (C. J. Smith, Baptist College, Chmn.) Last meeting 12/10. The meeting involved discussion of tenure, committee assignments, office space, etc., in cases of faculty exchange, with agreement that "one-course" exchange would be continued on interinstitutional agreement with reimbursement of consort college to parent institution. Citadel has approved credit for courses not in parent college catalog (with prior approval of Dean and department head). Next meeting: January 28, Citadel. Topic: Academic calendars and course schedules.

Liaison with Two-Year Colleges (J.H. Edmondson, Palmer, Chmn.) Last meeting 1/12. Two year institutions are interested in programs available in Charleston area, exchange of calendars and schedules of events, exchange of listing of research and projects of special interest, exchange of courses, a study of transferability, library usage agreements, and their role within the total consortium. Next meeting: February 24, Baptist College.

Library (J.M. Hilliard, The Citadel, Chmn.) Last meeting: 8/13. Has been working on ratification of agreement for cooperative library sharing among institutional members. Next meeting: February unscheduled.

Marine Science (H. W. Freeman, College of Charleston, Chmn.) Last meeting: 10/23. The committee has proposed a consortium Masters' degree for 1972-73 in Marine Science. This was submitted to the Steering Committee and returned for more work. Next meeting: unscheduled.

Policy (J. A. Morris, CHE, Chmn.) Next meeting scheduled 1/21 at the Citadel.

Steering (W.E. Anderson, The Citadel, Chmn.) Last meeting 12/11. The committee commended Citadel programs leading to AB in Mathematics and BS in Psychology to the Policy Committee for approval. The committee commended favorably a slightly revised version of the Faculty-Student Exchange Committee's 11-point recommendations on student exchange and forwarded this to the Policy Committee. Next meeting: unscheduled. Topic: Administrative structure for consortium program leading to graduate degrees, with particular reference to an M.Ed.
