The house at 7 Maple Circle is a Split Level type house with a two-story portion on its east end and a one-story portion on its west end. It has a hipped roof clad in asphalt shingles and a brick veneer exterior. Between the one-story and two-story portions of the house is a recessed central entrance approached by a brick stoop with an iron railing. Fenestration includes both single and paired sets of one-over-one windows and a three-part picture window on the facade. The house does not have a chimney.
