Dear Mr. Thomas:

South Carolina is in the process of implementing the MCSIA requirements. In order to put in place the necessary practices and congressionally mandated program requirements of MCSIA, each state must go through and pass two structured testing plans with AAMVA prior to implementing the necessary program changes into production. AAMVA has been working with the jurisdictions on scheduling the structured testing. South Carolina is scheduled to begin the first structured test on April 26, 2006 and the process will take approximately 3 weeks if all phases pass. The second test is scheduled to being May 15, 2006 and will take approximately 8 weeks if all phases pass.

South Carolina is confident that we will have all the requirements implemented after the structured testing has passed.
