Greetings! My name is Lance [REDACTED] and I'm [REDACTED] in Beverly, Ma. On July 18th, we'll be celebrating/honoring the life and legacy of Nathan Dane.

Dane was a key contributor to the Northwest Ordinance of 1787, who introduced the amendment that forbid the expansion of slavery into that territory (Indiana, Ohio, Illinois, Wisconsin, Michigan, and part of Minnesota). It was the first prohibition of slavery in our nation's history. In lobbying the country to ratify the 13th amendment Lincoln pointed to Dane's 1787 amendment as precedent that the federal govt can act on the issue of slavery. 2015 marks the 150th anniversary of the 13th amendment's ratification. Letters of commemoration from each states' Governor, within the area once known as the NW Territory, have started to arrive for the event. In light of the courageous stand that Governor Haley has taken on the Confederate Flag, I thought I'd also reach out to her and see if her office will provide a letter of commemoration for the July 18th event to honor Dane and the ratification of the 13th Amendment. I'm in conversation with the Ma. Governor to declare Nathan Dane Day in Massachusetts.
