Dear Members of the General Assembly,

At the continued request of governors from around the country, US HHS has released more specific numbers regarding the placement of illegal minors who have crossed the border, otherwise known as unaccompanied children or “UACs”.

Today, US HHS is making public the names of counties that have received 50 or more UACs since January 1, 2014, of which South Carolina has two: Beaufort County with 56 UACs; and Greenville County with 106 UACs. The Governor wanted you to be aware of this additional information – see below for more details.

Dear Colleague:

Thank you for your interest in the humanitarian response to the unaccompanied children crossing the U.S. border. Unaccompanied children are children who come to the U.S. from other countries without an adult guardian. The Office of Refugee Resettlement within HHS’ Administration for Children and Families (ACF) provides care for these children in shelters around the country until they can be placed with a sponsor, generally a parent or family relative, who can care for the child while their immigration case is processed.

In response to inquiries on the number of unaccompanied children placed with sponsors in their state, ACF has posted the aggregated state-by-state placement numbers on its website: <http://www.acf.hhs.gov/programs/orr/programs/ucs/state-by-state-uc-placed-sponsors>

In addition, we have received requests for more local information from Governors and other officials, including on last month’s call with Secretary Burwell. Today, ACF is also providing a breakdown of the numbers of children released to sponsors by the counties where the sponsors live, where 50 or more children have been released since January 1, 2014 (see table below). This information will also be posted at 4:00 pm EDT today at www.acf.hhs.gov/programs/orr/unaccompanied-children-released-to-sponsors-by-county. This county-level data, covering 113 counties nationwide, comprises 27,706 of the 37,477 total children released to sponsors in this period. ACF will

update this data each month.

HHS has strong policies in place to ensure the privacy and safety of unaccompanied children by maintaining the confidentiality of their personal information. We cannot release information about individual children that could compromise the child's location or identity. These children have frequently been victims of violence, targeted by gangs or traffickers, and many have suffered during the journey they have undertaken. In order to protect the privacy and confidentiality of this vulnerable population, it is imperative that the names and addresses of those they are released to are kept confidential.
