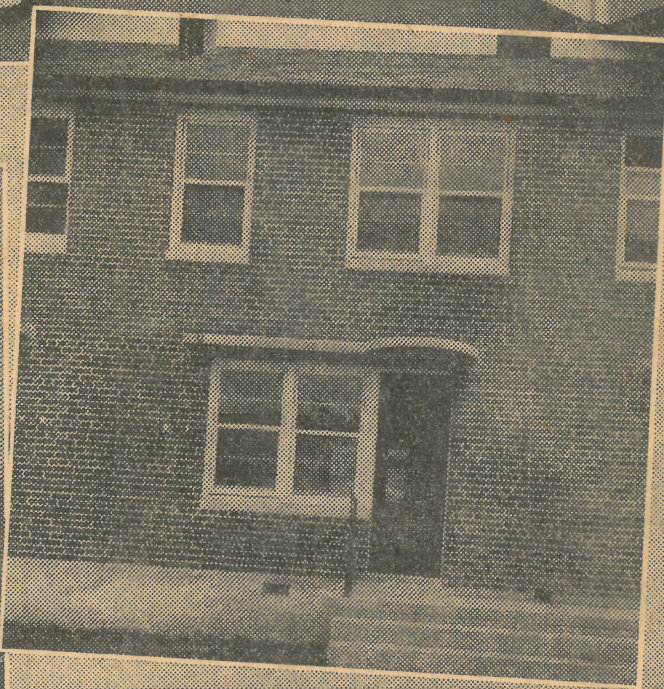
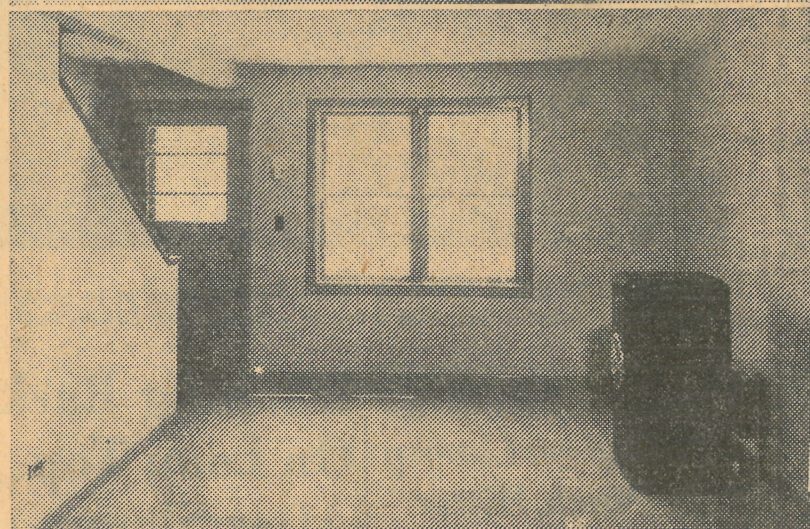
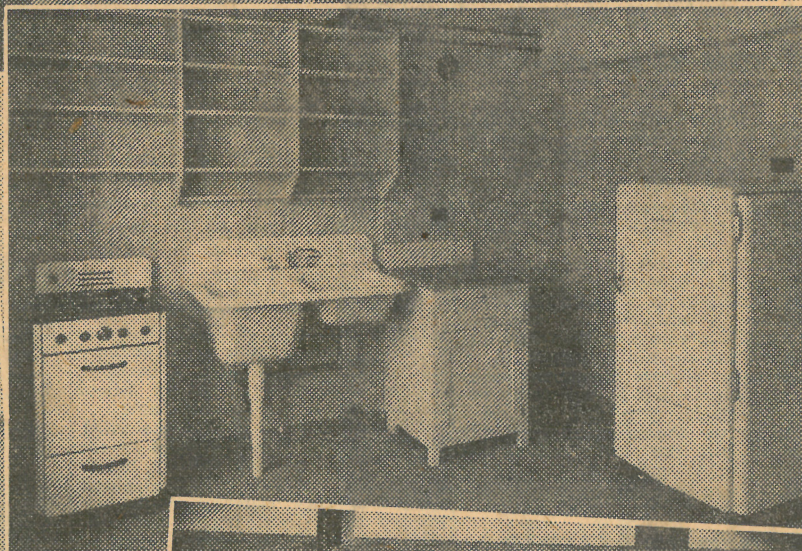
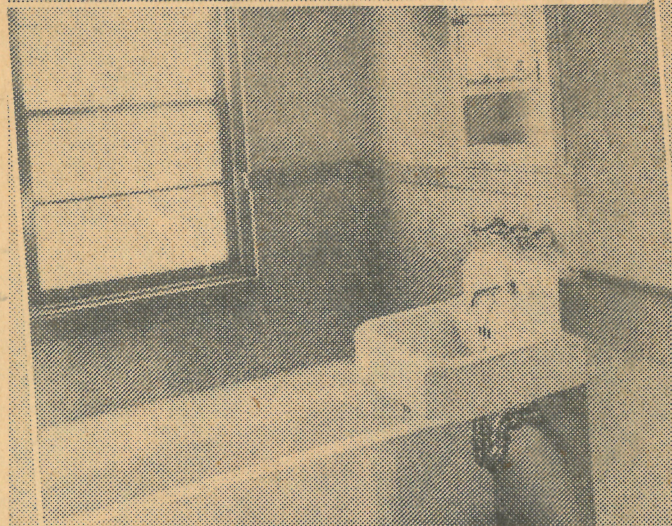
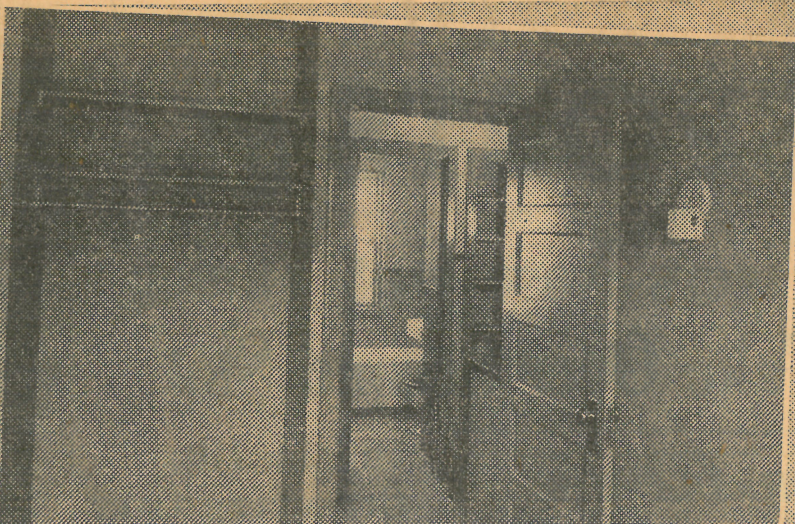
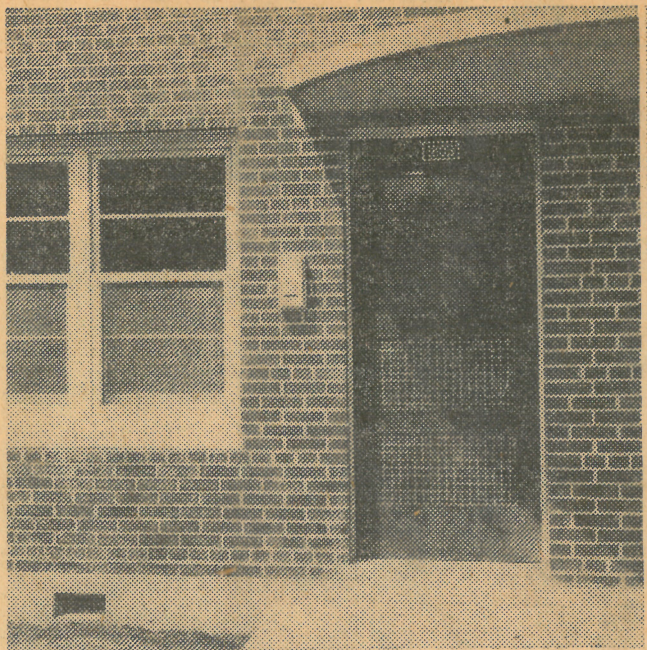


Scenes at Gonzales Gardens, Housing Project



Above are six scenes at Gonzales Gardens, Columbia's new \$1,000,000 housing project for white families, located on Forest Drive across from the Providence hospital. Top row, left, is shown the front entrance to a unit; right, an interior view, illustrating ample closet space provided; second row, left, typical bathroom; right, the kitchen, showing gas stove, shelves, double sink, work cabinet and electric

refrigerator, all of which are supplied in the rent along with gas and electricity; bottom row, left, a living room with oil space heater included in rent; right, back entrance to one of the units. Every apartment has yard space. Rents for Gonzales Gardens as announced by the Columbia Housing Authority are from \$7.65 to \$16.75 per month, including utilities. Families making from \$360 to \$900 per year will

be eligible for units, depending on the size apartment and the number of persons in the family. A three-room unit rent ranges from \$7.65 to \$14 per month; four-room from \$9.90 to \$15.75; five-room unit from \$10.90 to \$16.75. Applications for units are now being taken at the Tenant Selection Office, University Terrace, 627 Bull street. Applications are not binding but serve to let the local authority

know that the applicant is interested in securing a unit. Miss Mae Bridges has been named as Tenant Selection Supervisor. Information concerning the new units can be secured at the Tenant Selection Office, which is open daily from 8 a. m. to 6 p. m. It is expected that typical units will be open to public inspection at Gonzales Gardens shortly.
