#### Description/Significant Features:

1-story lateral gable roof commercial building, constructed ca. 1970, faces Shem Creek with the gable ends parallel to the creek. The wood frame building is clad in a weatherboard siding and the roof is clad in asphalt shingle. The foundation is obscured but is raised as there is a grand wooden staircase at the entrance on the west elevation. Windows are various wood frame, wood-sash windows. A lighthouse, also ca. 1970, is situated adjacent to the building's northeast corner.

100 Church Street, with its black-and-white lighthouse, once housed a seafood restaurant named The Trawler before becoming an event venue, Lighthouse on Shem Creek. Now the building houses Tavern & Table.
