Gentlemen:

Under provisions of the General Appropriation Bill for 1943-44, there is a proviso which specifies that the salaries enumerated in the Bill shall be in full for services rendered with further stipulation that the Budget Commission may suspend the provisions of this proviso, upon written satisfactory proof being presented by the State Board of Health, that any person or persons should be allowed an increase compensation from outside sources. It further provides that the Commission shall specify in detail the amount of increase that may be allowed, designating the person by name, title and position.

For the past several years we have been presenting this evidence, and it appears that one authorization should be sufficient. However, to prevent any confusion, we herewith submit by name, and title, all persons receiving additional compensation from outside sources for this year over the amount provided in the General Appropriation Bill.

We beg to call to your attention, under Item 8, Dental Hygiene, that the Secretary and Clerical Help have already been raised under your authorization to the figure named. It should be recognized by your honorable body, that Doctor Wyman is Director of Rural Sanitation and County Health Work, and receives salary from the State, and this is a special allotment from the Federal Government, and which has heretofore been approved by your Commission.
