We were planning to distribute a release regarding Mitsubishi Polyester Film's \$100 million Upstate expansion next week. However, we found out today that the company would like to go ahead and make their announcement tomorrow (Friday) afternoon in advance of a major industry trade show taking place on Sunday. There are no new jobs associated with this expansion. The \$100 million investment will facilitate equipment upgrades at the Greer, S.C. plant.
