Small Flock Certification Program

Clemson University Extension Service and the SC Department of Agriculture have developed the Small Flock Certification Program, designed to bring small poultry flocks into compliance with the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP). Since the commercial poultry industry in South Carolina is valued at \$1.5 billion, preventing disease infestations between small and/or commercial flocks is essential. In addition, following the NPIP provides small flock owners with better quality poultry.

The criteria for becoming certified in the program requires that each flock be NPIP Certified and the flock owner be a certified tester. NPIP workshops will be offered twice a year.

To be certified, small flock owners must be a member in a state or national poultry organization including: American Poultry Association, American Bantam Association, Anderson Bantam Club of SC, SC Game Fowl Breeders Association, United Game Fowl Association, Southeastern Game Bird Breeders and Hunting Preserve Association, North American Game Bird Association, Carolinas/Virginia Pheasant and Waterfowl Association, American Pheasant & Waterfowl Association, or any other poultry organization recognized and approved by Clemson University or the SC Department of Agriculture. The purpose of membership in a recognized poultry organization is not only to strengthen these organizations but also to insure the highest quality birds and management systems and to help in the dissemination of educational programs.

Commissioner's Column

Balanced Diet & Exercise---a winning combination of Olympic proportions!



Sasha Cohen, the 17-year-old figure skating sensation, won a spot on the U.S. Ladies' Figure Skating Team by finishing second behind Michelle Kwan at the U.S. National Championships. Now, she's showing what she can do at the 2002 Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City.

Sasha practices hard. She skates hours and hours on the ice six days a week. A key part of her training includes eating the right food to be strong and healthy. And, beef is part of her healthy diet.

Last year, Sasha joined the beef producers of this state and nation in a campaign to help young girls know the benefits of eating smart and staying fit. So far, this message has reached approximately 10 million girls. Soon, Sasha will appear in advertising in youth magazines funded by beef producers through the checkoff program.

The South Carolina Beef Board initiates programs that ensure the most efficient and effective use of those producer checkoff dollars. One dollar per head on all cattle sold in the state is collected for the checkoff program. Half of that dollar is retained in the state for projects and programs. The other half goes to the Cattlemen's Beef Promotion and Research Board. The Beef Board focuses on promotion, consumer information/education, research, industry information, producer communications and market development. Based on South Carolina's population and the current per capita consumption of beef (69.4 retail weight lbs. per person), a total of about 2.5 billion pounds of beef is consumed annually in the state. So, beef is not only an important part of a well-balanced diet---in South Carolina . . . "Beef. It's really what's for dinner!"

Beef is rich in protein for building muscle and repairing body tissues, B-vitamins for healthy skin and good vision, iron for energy, and zinc for helping form important things like enzymes and insulin.

Sasha said, "I need lots of energy for training and competing. That can be a challenge! Eating nutritious foods is really important. If you take care of your body, you know that you are doing what is best for you. You can take control of how you feel about yourself! You can't help but feel good on the inside and the outside when you eat smart and stay active!"

Sasha has provided 10 tips for staying healthy.

1. Eating smart helps build your mind, body and spirit.
2. Eat a variety of foods in reasonable amounts.
3. Fad diets just don't work! So why waste your time with them?
4. Turn to nutrient-rich foods to fuel your healthy life.
5. Need a boost? Just remember ZIP! Foods with Zinc, Iron and Protein are important to energize your body.

Longleaf Seedlings Available

For the first time in several years, the South Carolina Forestry Commission's Taylor Nursery has surplus longleaf seedlings available for sale to the public. Longleaf seedlings have been in such short supply in previous years that a lottery has been used to ensure their fair distribution. However, their scarcity has caused some landowners to give up on planting longleaf after repeatedly not being able to locate them anywhere in the Southeast.

Excellent germination and growth of seedlings at Taylor Nursery last spring and summer, combined with the lack of a USDA Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) signup for longleaf planting last year, have resulted in a surplus of 2.1 million bareroot longleaf seedling that are still available for sale. They are available in 1,000, 500, and 100 count bags for \$85, \$45, and \$16 respectively. Orders should be placed as soon as possible since spring is just around the corner.

Anybody interested in ordering seedlings should call Lisa Mason at 803-896-8910. Seedlings can be conveniently picked up at the South Carolina Forestry Commission seedling coolers located in Edgefield, Colleton, Spartanburg, and Sumter Counties.

In addition, small flock owners must attend a 12-hour (1.5 day) workshop to learn poultry management concepts and principles. The workshop will be offered once a year. Also, to maintain certification in the program, small flock owners must attend a follow-up 8-hour (1 day) workshop to be held annually for continuing education.

Topics for the educational programs include: NPIP Certification; Poultry Diseases; Poultry Parasites; Necropsy and Pathology; Nutrition Basics and Feed Formulation; Biosecurity; Pest and Rodent Control; Farm Management Program (HACCP for the Small Flock Owner); and Being a Good Neighbor. Topics for the continuing education programs include: Genetics; Record Keeping; Agriculture Laws, Rules and Regulations; Housing; Management; Disease Prevention; Cleaning and Disinfection; and Biosecurity.

An on-farm inspection will be performed by a Clemson University Extension Specialist to assure that the flock owner is adhering to the criteria endorsed in the educational workshops.

Upon completion of the criteria to become certified, a license will be granted by the SC Department of Agriculture.

Nominal fees will be charged to cover the costs of the workshops, license, roadside signage and inspection.
