Governor Nikki Haley has ordered an evacuation for most of the South Carolina coast beginning at 3 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 5, in response to Hurricane Matthew.

This affects the following state parks:

- Hunting Island State Park
- Edisto Beach State Park
- Huntington Beach State Park
- Myrtle Beach State Park
- Givhans Ferry State Park
- Colleton State Park
- Charles Towne Landing SHS
- Colonial Dorchester SHS
- Hampton Plantation SHS

These parks closed beginning Wednesday, October 5, 2016.

South Carolina State Parks will work with its customers on reservations. Please contact the call center at 1-866-345-PARK (7275) for assistance. Please be patient as we are expecting higher than normal call volume during this period.

While we don't know when or if the hurricane will make landfall in South Carolina, the state, in an abundance of caution, has assumed a heightened level of preparedness.
