Just talked to Ted about this; here is the rundown just so everyone is in the loop. Ken came by to talk about DEW and a couple of other things:

- (1) I'm working with Deb at DEW to get Ken some additional legal guidance on the meaning of "cause" in S 1125. There is another LCI hearing scheduled next week. Even though Gen. Turner is in the hospital, the subcommittee will still likely meet.
- (2) A Senate Judiciary Oversight subcommittee has been created and will essentially follow the "Legislative Oversight" bill template to go ahead and begin reviewing programs/agencies under their existing authority. Ken is staffing it and will be the point person if we have questions.
- (3) As an aside, he mentioned that he is working on a new DOA bill for Massey and Sheheen.
