Staterooms will feature additional drawers in closets, improved lighting and stone tops on desks and nightstands. Headboards will have USB and electrical outlets on both sides of the bed. Among accommodations are 12 ocean-view staterooms for solo travelers and 32 family ocean-view staterooms that hold up to five passengers.

Royal Caribbean and the World Wildlife Fund will embark on a five-year partnership to help protect the world's oceans. They've set goals to reduce the cruise company's environmental footprint and raise awareness of ocean conservation among passengers; the line also will source most of its seafood from certified sustainable fisheries and farms. Royal Caribbean will donate \$5 million toward the WWF's efforts as well.
