- ☐ **S.267 – Shortening Session** (statute to end session one month earlier and reschedule the BEA estimates accordingly) ⑧ Passed unanimously 22-0. The House's version, a constitutional amendment (3014), was carried over or recommitted.
- ☐ **Tort Reform Bills 281/282** ⑧ Carried over for a few weeks for Senators to meet with stakeholders.
- ☐ **647 (recording police officers in public)** ⑧ Passed 19-2; many amendments on the floor expected; members to talk to law enforcement and contemplate victims' rights.
- ☐ 524 (consecutive sentencing for indecent exposure in prisons) ⑧ Passed 19-0.
- ☐ 3682 (patent trolling bill; Bad Faith Assertion of Patient Infringement Act) ⑧ Passed 16-3.
