**DID YOU KNOW?** The Red Wolves at Charles Towne Landing are members of the Species Survival Plan. The Red Wolf is listed as a critically endangered species. Currently they number around 200 held in 43 facilities throughout the United States, and about 120 in the wild at the Alligator River Wildlife Refuge in North Carolina. These numbers are up from just 17 Red Wolves that were the last of their species in the wild in the mid-1970s before being placed into the species survival plan.
