I have received an email from Experian ID Protection that the subscription provided by the State of South Carolina will expire as of July 31, 2015.

I contacted the SC Dept. of Revenue as to whether the subscription will be continued by the State and was informed they had received no information as to the continuation of the protection by the State for the individuals who may have had their private tax information hacked into. The Dept. of Revenue suggested that I contact the State Legislation for information regarding the continuation of the protection or whether the State residents should seek protection on their own.

Are you aware of any continuation by the State? Would you please advise accordingly?

I would appreciate a reply as the email from Experian indicates the coverage terminates as of July 31st.
