Katherine,

I'll be in Columbia this afternoon and am glad to answer questions about the University of South Carolina Beaufort funding request.

Currently, both the House and Senate versions of the budget include a \$1.2 M increase for USCB.

This increase simply brings USCB up to the level of the next lowest funded public institution in the state on a per South Carolina resident served basis (Senator Davis exhibit attached). This "level playing field" action is a prerequisite for accountability based funding in South Carolina.
