Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, since its founding in 1916, Boeing has been a pioneer in the aerospace industry, utilizing exceptional leadership and innovation to grow into the largest aerospace company in the world; and

WHEREAS, in addition to commercial jetliners, including the Dreamliner 787-10 built exclusively at the North Charleston plant, Boeing's products and services include military aircraft, satellites, weapons, electronic and defense systems, launch systems, advanced information and communication systems, and performance-based logistics and training; and

WHEREAS, Boeing is a significant contributor to South Carolina's economy, employing approximately 8,000 individuals, supporting about 10,000 direct and indirect jobs, partnering with 300 suppliers and making purchases of \$355 million from in-state suppliers and vendors, and generating more than \$17 billion in economic activity in the Palmetto State; and

WHEREAS, as a good neighbor and outstanding corporate citizen, Boeing has set a high standard for community involvement, partnering with numerous organizations and contributing millions of dollars each year to help improve the quality of life for people and communities in the Palmetto State.
