I am a 54 yo CHRISTIAN female who came to SC to retire last year. I am from NJ and purchased a home last August (with my retirement money) so that I would be Mortgage Free. I consider myself Blessed to have this opportunity. Not only did I purchase my home outright, but I spent another \$50k to remodel it completely. I support local businesses, my community, and am active in my local church.

I visited Columbia twice before house hunting. During one of my early visits I visited the Capitol grounds - particularly that awful flag. I had NO-IDEA it even existed anymore - let alone be on display on Government Property. I took pictures to share with friends and family up north. Everyone I shared it with was shocked, disgusted, and in disbelief. As I walked by, circled around, and prayed against it last summer I had this sick feeling in my Spirit. I was grieved that the sins of our fathers persisted and continued to CURSE this beautiful city.

I have been riveted by the events of the past few weeks and cheered in my living room as I watched your directive to TAKE THE FLAG DOWN. I was so proud that you are my Govenor "for a time such as this."

Last evening I found out about the Klan rally scheduled for July 18 from a friend (African-American Northerner who moved here 5 years ago).

My friend is a 62 yo Vietnam War Veteran who served as a Medic. He spent his entire career in the healthcare field - particularly in psychiatry - ever since. The Confederate Flag.....Please take time to Read.

I am the Confederate Battle Flag. My design is based upon the Saint Andrew's Cross of Scotland. Some prefer to call me the "Rebel Flag". Either name I will wear with honor. There is certainly no shame in being called Confederate, as the people who bore that same honorable title are remembered for their bravery on the field of battle, a Southern culture built upon hard work, and faith in God. As for the name "Rebel", it was the Revolutionary War soldier and outstanding pamphleteer, Thomas Paine, in his series "The American Crisis", said: "Let them call me Rebel and welcome -- I feel no concern from it". Because you see, it was George Washington and his Colonial Army who were the original Rebels. My boys in gray were the second to wear the

name.

My soldiers were so proud of me and held me in high esteem. Many songs and poems were written to praise me. Southern ladies especially loved me and often I was hand made by them and presented to Dixie's heroes at formal ceremonies. My folds still bare the brown stains of the blood of young heroes.

A poem by Abram Ryan said: "Once ten thousand hailed me gladly, and ten thousand wildly, madly, swore I should ever wave. For though conquered, they adore me! Love the cold dead hands that bore me! Weep for those that fell before me". I was carried high on Memorial Day, and Dixie was included in July 4th ceremonies. On Veteran's Day, my men marched along with those from other wars. I waved proudly beside state flags in front of every state building in the South. The great grandchildren of my soldiers put me in tag form on their vehicles and posted me proudly in front of their homes. At some universities, I became the rallying cry at athletic events. The descendants of my warriors remembered both them and me with honor and reverent pride.

But history began to be revised and things such as hard work, personal responsibility, chastity, civility, even Christian symbols such as the cross, the nativity, and the Ten Commandments became unpopular as society became more crude and coarse. I find that I, the once honored flag of the Confederacy, have become the primary targets of the speech police. I have heard of this thing called "diversity". And if I understand it correctly, it means that this country is working toward the inclusion of and equal treatment for all ethnic groups. Then why is my group singled out not only for omission, but also for slander?

The saddest part for me is that a great number of Confederate descendants have let the liberal media world convince them to be ashamed of who they are. Others have become afraid to display me. How I wish they could have seen their grandfathers hold my colors proudly at Shiloh, or witnessed the calm resolve at Gettysburg as General Pickett sent them forward into cannon and minie balls while I floated above their brave heads. There were no cowards at these places, only the valiant willing to die for the Constitution and the protection of their beloved homes.

Perhaps my people need to be reminded of who they are and what I am. I am a Christian symbol based on the Saint Andrew's Cross, the native flag of Scotland. According to tradition Saint Andrew, the patron saint of Scotland was crucified on an X-shaped cross. The X-shaped cross in my colors and in the flag of Scotland is also the Greek letter chi which has long been a Christian abbreviation for "Christ". 19th century military tactics required perfect alignment in order to fire effectively upon an enemy. This rigid formation depended upon being able to align troops on the flag. Therefore, I was the rallying point for the "boys in gray". But, I was respected by the Union, too. Union troops received the Congressional Medal of Honor for the capture of a Confederate Battle Flag. Because of the confusion between the similarity of first national flag of the CSA and the national flag of the USA, General P. G. T. Beauregard and Joseph E. Johnston adopted my design for their battle flag. I was first known as the Southern Cross and today I am generally referred to as the Confederate Battle Flag. Even the gaping bullet holes that appeared in me after every engagement were pointed to with pride as being further indication of valor for the men of the unit. It further reminds me of the courage and dedication were needed. Confederate soldiers had only to look at the blood stains of their fallen comrades which the battle action had placed upon my colors.

Even in the 20th Century I have been carried into battles for freedom. As the United Nations fought to protect South Korea from the aggression of North Korea, I flew over the front lines with the U. S. 7th Marines, 3rd Battalion, E Company ("The Civil War: Strange and Fascinating Facts," by Burke Davis). When the TV cameras scanned the crowds witnessing the fall of a communist dictatorship in Eastern Europe with the destruction of the Berlin Wall, I was seen waving in many hands in that sea of humanity. We are proud of your history proud of your scars and venerate you for your age, trusting that your scarred folds may be preserved for ages to come and when time and its inevitable ravages shall dissolve your sacred folds into dust, may the patriotic emotions which actuated us in that memorial struggle pervade American hearts and live in vivid memories of Southern heroism and Southern chivalry.

Why do my people not still love me? Why do they not display me on their government buildings and their businesses? Above all, why do they not fly me on the occasions of Confederate Memorial Day (fourth Monday in April), General Lee's birthday (third Monday in January) and President Davis's birthday (June third)? Perhaps they just need to become reacquainted with who I REALLY AM not who those who hate me SAY THAT I AM. Remember and honor me openly, my children. I was based on a Christian symbol; represented a fight for independence, carried by fearless men; and loved by your grandparents. I am The Confederate Battle Flag. Fly me proudly. I am your Inheritance.

Letting no tragedy go to waste

The funeral processions to the graveyards in Charleston will be crowded unless the families can keep out the interlopers, exploiters and other cheap opportunists. The easy riders have hitched up their hobbyhorses for the big parade.

Some of the long riders want to shoot down the Confederate flag. Others have oiled their long rifles for the promised cavalry charge against the National Rifle Association. Even the Arabs, who have never distinguished themselves on a battlefield, want to join the mob to avenge murder of Christians at Charleston.

The soldiers of CAIR, the loudest Muslim lobbying organization, joins the crusade to tear down the Confederate flag wherever they find it, as "a fitting memorial to those slain in one of America's deadliest acts of racist violence." CAIR needs help with American history. Massacre at the World Trade Center, where more than 3,000 Americans were slain for the sin of being Christians, Jews and unbelievers, set the standard for massacre. Punks and crazies eager to get their names in the Guinness Book of Records will be shooting at 9/11 for decades to

come.

Gov. Nikki Haley, the governor of South Carolina, surrendered to the mob late Monday, joining the demand to send the Confederate flag to "the dustbin of history," as one leader of the mob put it. The governor called the rally, where several state officials, including Sen. Lindsey Graham, gathered in a ceremony to join the mob, "a moment of unity." The Republican National Committee, always eager to cower in the face of controversy, praised the governor. Chairman Reince Priebus assured everyone that he has been praying for South Carolina but forgot the "thoughts" that politicians, not known for dropping to their knees except before donors, usually attach to their "prayers" when they invoke clichés on occasions of tragedy.

There's an argument for furling the banner of Lee, Jackson and the Confederate soldiers who died in great numbers defending kith, kin, home and hearth from plundering invading armies, and thoughtful men and women could make that argument. None have tried. Taking down the flag from government buildings won't eliminate the flag from abuse of the trash who despoil it, nor would it relieve the pain of those rendered prostrate by the sight of the St. Andrews Cross fluttering in the breeze. The flag will almost certainly become more popular than ever as an act of defiance of the politically correct who dream of strangling free speech and all expressions of opinion not Officially Approved. If the flag is so bad, where have they been all these years?

A certain kind of Republican, like the worthies at the national committee, is always eager to prove that "we're not as bad as you think," and expect to be rewarded with flattering mentions in the press. It never happens, and they never learn. They dream of surrendering on "immigration reform," too, and would cave on the Second Amendment as well but for their fears, soundly based, that if they do they will never be heard from again.

Hillary Clinton's Charleston shtick is not the Confederate flag, but guns, and how to best exploit the Charleston tragedy. "Let's just cut to the chase," she told one interviewer. "It's guns and we have to have a better balance." No guns on one hand, and no guns on the other hand is the perfect balance she prescribes. She and Bubba have been successful robbers without guns, so who needs them?

Taking a cue from their partisan leader, the Democrats are trying to out-do each other in coming up with the most deeply purple eloquence against shooting people in church. (They're all against it.) Sen. Bernie Sanders, the strongest, or at least the most visible, needle in Hillary's backside, talks not of the Confederate flag or guns but "the ugly stain of racism."

Martin O'Malley, the former governor of Maryland, uses a urinary vulgarism to express the depth of his disdain for shooting children. "I'm [urinating]," he says. "I'm [urinating] that we're actually asking ourselves the horrific question of 'what will it take?'"

Not quite every politician is acting the jerk. Gov. Chris Christie of New Jersey understands that further refining of gun laws won't prevent another massacre. The urge to kill and maim lies not in laws. Only a change in the culture, as slow and painful as that may be, he told a gathering of the Faith and Freedom Coalition, will do that.

If every Confederate flag had long ago been hauled down and burned, if racism had been banished completely, Dylann Roof, a young man with a distorted soul, hatred in his heart and armed with determination, would still have satisfied his sick urge to kill. Evil will find a way to the willing heart. Robert E. Lee's flag has nothing to do with it.
