## REPORT: Dislocated Workers Find New Jobs Faster with Skills Credentials

Skills Credentials, Speed to Employment: Two new reports from ACT demonstrate how dislocated workers in Ohio benefit from earning industry-recognized skills credentials.

### Case Study

When workers learn that they will lose their jobs due to plant closings, skills credentials can help them find new employment more quickly. A case study describes how dislocated manufacturing workers in the Cincinnati, OH, area improved their opportunities by taking ACT WorkKeys® tests and earning the Certified Production Technician (CPT) designation. Higher ACT WorkKeys scores increased the chances of qualifying for the CPT and shortened the time to employment.

### Research Brief

The positive outcome for Cincinnati workers has broader implications. Independent research conducted jointly by ACT and the Manufacturing Skills Standards Council (MSSC) compared scores achieved on ACT WorkKeys Applied Mathematics and Reading for Information exams with success in qualifying for the CPT.
