TUESDAY TIDBIT -- ON WEDNESDAY! We have a visitor at Hunting Island State Park -- The Sandhill Crane is a long-legged, long-necked bird with a naked red forehead and slate or brown-gray plumage. Adults have a white chin, cheek and upper throat and black primaries. The young have a feathered head and chocolate-brown plumage with some rusty color. Sandhill cranes have are 34 to 38" in length and weigh 8-10 pounds. Preening with muddy bills, cranes may stain feathers of upper back, lower neck and breast with ferrous solution contained in the mud. During migration, they fly in V-formations or make long lines. Their calls can be heard for miles. They have an unforgettable trumpeting call of gar-oo-oo. It is produced by a modified windpipe that has been likened to a French horn.
