My mother is only able to have her home one night at a time simply because she often worries about her falling. Carol Lynn Sisk is probably the smartest person I know. Her mind is Brilliant her Heart is filled with Love and it never changes. For those of you receiving this email know exactly what I am talking about.

I would like to share a quick story that took place last year as Carol and my mother were visiting us for Christmas. The plan was for Carol to take a bath, however it is super difficult for Carol to get in and out of the tub without the risk of a fall. The plan was to have Carol put on one of my large T shirts. We were then going draw the bath and as it was filling up I was going to help her in. Bingo mission accomplished. I left the shirt came off (SKEET) had a wonderful bath in a different tub---ALL SMILES. 15 minutes later I'm summonsed for part #2. Getting her out. Shirt goes back on, I climb in the giggles start to flow we are all in stiches knowing all along this can't happen we need to focus. After several minutes we attempted to get her out. My plan DID NOT work, Carol elbowed me in the ribs looked at me and said "I KNOW HOW". Carol was able to grab the soap tray handle with one hand and place her other hand on the side of the tub. The first attempt she slipped a little bit but managed to catch herself. On the second attempt she popped up all smiles and said I TOLD YOU. I agreed. Carol has always wanted to do for herself, that is her personality and we wouldn't have it any other way. She is our BLESSING and she is my STAR.

So I write this today looking for help and an avenue to go down to try to have a walk in tub installed in Carols home. When the tubs were first introduce in the 70's and 80's the prices were extreme and only the wealthy could afford them.
