My involment with Dr. John "Jack" Mayer started back in 2010 when he brought to my attention that to be able to use toxic bait he needed a feeder to help eradicate feral hogs. There would need to be a delivery system to feed only wild hogs. It was my understanding that his involvement with South Carolina and Savannah River National Laboratory was research regarding the wild hog. I was told by Dr. Mayer that he would test the feeder. I had one made and delivered to him. I have a bunch of pictures and e-mails documenting from him regarding his testing at the Savannah site. Through this he indicated to me that it worked and wrote me a letter as well for me to use to locate manufactures to produce the feeder. Moving forward, Dr. Mayer told me he did not want me to use his name or Savannah River National Laboratory. I have traveled all over the United States from one research laboratory to the next and I have been getting feedback that Dr. Mayer is claiming he has never tested the feeder. I have spoken with the EPA and they have expressed to me if there would have been other bait brought forward and if they had known that there was a delivery system, there is a possibility this problem could have been dealt with a few years ago. We could have saved billions of tax dollars. I have been told by some of these research laboratories there not going forward on anything as long as they are getting research money. Governor Haley, I spent almost 6 years and a lot of my own money on this problem. Since Dr. Mayer brought this to my attention. I would appreciate if someone would explain this corruption so that I could make the right decision. Dr. Mayer is not willing to write up the test results for me to present to the EPA. I am trying to go to Texas at the last minute to have it tested. If I am not able participate, then the State of South Carolina would have perform their own test to go forward with the EPA.
