Dear Governor Haley,

We wish to share with you an upcoming change in our food production plan for 2015 that offers a significant and positive economic impact for Florence County and for the great State of South Carolina.

This change is the result of an acquisition that we made at the end of 2013, which included the purchase of the Bruce's Yams brand of sweet potatoes, white potatoes and vegetables, along with two processing plants in Louisiana and North Carolina. We operated the two plants throughout 2014, as we integrated the administrative functions of Bruce's Yams into our corporate headquarters in Effingham. Now, as 2014 comes to a close, we have decided to relocate all of the manufacturing functions into Effingham as well. This change will result in a significant expansion in our production facilities here, along with the creation of approximately 200 new jobs.

Combined with the recent expansion of our Effingham Plant, and our reliance on South Carolina family-owned and operated farms for our raw vegetables, McCall Farms is overjoyed at the support that we can provide to our state's economy and the lives that are, and will be, enriched as employees of McCall Farms.

We know that our growth would not be possible without the support of our state's government leaders such as you. Please accept our sincere appreciation for all that you have done and continue to do to make South Carolina an ideal state for corporations such as McCall Farms to grow and prosper.
