SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of April 20, 2006; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving amendments to the 2005 STIP, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of surplus right of way property, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending an existing bituminous retreatment contract to include additional work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending existing construction contracts to include additional work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department related to roads in the State Highway Secondary System, as shown in detail in the Appendix. It is noted that no SCDOT funds will be spent for the removal of a section of road from SC Route 14 at Pelham easterly, designated as S-63 in Spartanburg County. Spartanburg Regional Medical Center has agreed to pay all costs associated with the removal of this road.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the highway letting of April 11, 2006, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: On behalf of the members of the Commission, Executive Director Mabry presented a memory box to outgoing Commissioner J. M. "Moot" Truluck.

SECTION 9: Commissioner Jones reported for the Invitations and Resolutions Committee and made a motion for Commission approval for the following resolutions:

- Concurrent Resolution naming a portion of US 221 in Laurens the "Joe B. Medlock Memorial Highway"
- Concurrent Resolution naming Twin Church Road and Alligator Road in Florence as "Hicks Crossroads"
- Concurrent Resolution naming the portion of Highway 76 in Marion County from the Pee Dee River Bridge to the Highway 301 bridge the "Representative Mack T. Hines Highway".

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Harrell and passed unanimously. Copies of the resolutions are included in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: Commissioner Carnell reported for the Legislative Committee. The committee met and was given an update on the legislative session. Federal earmarks were also discussed at the committee meeting. A report on earmarks will be prepared for the next committee meeting.

SECTION 11: Commissioner Harrell reported for the Finance and Administration Committee. The committee received financial information from Mr. Mo Denny. No action was taken. The committee requests future meetings be allotted two and one-half hours.

Surplus Property Public Notice

May 18, 2006

In accordance with the State of South Carolina Statute 57-5-340, by this publication the Department is making public the Surplus Property Real Estate Transactions to the State Highway Commission. The following sheets include a breakdown of surplus property real estate transactions. These transactions may have resulted from negotiations with property owners during right of way acquisition, direct sales, settlement of a condemnation action, and/or corrective actions to previously reported sales.

1. File 32.761 / Route I-26 / Lexington County / Second District

During construction of interchange improvements at Route I-26 and Road S-671 (Piney Grove Road), under File 32.761 in Lexington, near the Town of Irmo, the Department acquired right of way for Route I-26 and Road S-671, by Title to Real Estate from Exxon Corporation, formerly Humble Oil and Refining Company dated May 20, 1993.

A request was received from an adjacent landowner asking to purchase the remainder of a landlocked parcel of land adjoining his property. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Departments needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.06 acres of land to Pantry Express, LLC was executed on March 27, 2006, in consideration of \$60,000.00.

2. File 2.140B / Route I-520 / Aiken County / Second District

During construction of improvements on Road S-1445, under File 2.551 in Aiken County, in the City of North Augusta, the Department acquired property from Eric Brandenburg by Quitclaim Deed dated March 22, 1996.

An exchange of property was negotiated for new right of way for Route I-520 with the Grantee. The Grantee requested to receive the quitclaim deed from the Department before he would close on property needed for the new right of way for Route I-520. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.30 of an acre of land to Merrell L. Stout, Jr. was executed on April 4, 2006.

3. File 23.167B / SC Route 290 & SC Route 101 / Greenville County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 101 in Greenville County, near the City of Greer, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 101 under the Beltline Act.

During negotiations for right of way at the intersection of SC Route 101 and SC Route 290 under File 23.167B, the Department agreed to quitclaim an abandoned section of SC Route 101 to the adjacent owner in exchange for new right of way for the project. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.24 of an acre of land to Earl R. Taylor was executed on April 4, 2006.

4. File 7.257 / Road S-34 / Beaufort County / Second District

During construction of improvements on Road S-34, under File No. 7.257 near the Town of Bluffton in Beaufort County, the Department acquired a sight triangle for Road S-34 at the intersection with SC Route 46, by Deed to Right of Way from Daisy Boulware dated October 18, 1950.

A request was received from Pritchardville 46, LLC, the adjacent landowner, asking the Department to relinquish a portion of the present 50' x 50' foot triangular area referenced above. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that a portion of the site triangle could be relinquished to the adjacent property owner in exchange for fee simple title to the remaining new 30' x 30' foot triangular area. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.02 of an acre of land to Pritchardville 46, LLC was executed on April 10, 2006.

5. File 23.188A / US Route 25 / Greenville County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on US Route 25, under File 23.188A in Greenville County, near Moonville, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 25, by Title to Real Estate from Horace O. Smith dated October 3, 1989.

A request was received from the adjacent landowner asking the Department to convey a small triangle that was not included in the deed during a previous right of way settlement. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 320 square feet of land to KKC & G, LLC was executed on April 13, 2006, in consideration of \$1,000.00.

6. File 2.812 / SC Route 302 / Aiken County / Second District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 302, under File 2.812 in Aiken County, near the City of Aiken, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 302, by Title to Real Estate from Jack P. & Lorenz S. Woodward dated November 12, 1999.

An agreement was made between Homesites, LTD, (contractor) and former DEA Jim Cagney for the existing detention pond, constructed by SCDOT during construction of SC Route 302 (Pine Log Road). The contractor will construct a new pond facility that will accommodate the total needs of the Department as well as the adjacent development. It is further agreed that the Department will have future use of the detention pond and will be released from future liability. In return, the Department has agreed to convey the detention pond (6.268 acres) at the completion of the project and pay the contractor to assist with the construction of cost. The work has been completed and approved by both the City of Aiken and our District One office. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 6.268 acres of land to Homesites, LTD, was executed on April 13, 2006.

7. File 8.689 / US Route 52 / Berkeley County / First District

During acquisition on US Route 52, in Berkeley County, near the Town of St. Stephens, the Department acquired a borrow pit from Santee Bridge District by Title to Real Estate dated June 6, 1925.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate its surplus inventory, the subject parcel was given to a real estate consultant. The property was marketed to the public with the Grantee making the highest offer. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 41.75 acres of land to Larry Joe Peters and Theresa Bolen Peters was executed on April 4, 2006, in consideration of \$65,000.00.

8. File 10.416A/8.787/ US Route 52/US Route 78 / Charleston County / First District

During construction of improvements on US Route 78/US Route 52, under File No. 10.416A/8.787, in the City of North Charleston in Charleston County, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-1439 by Condemnation from Charles T. Cheers and Lois J. Cheers dated November 16, 1999.

A request was made by Charles T. Cheers and Lois J. Cheers for any surplus right of way at the intersection of Road S-1439 and US Route 78 Frontage Road in order for them to develop their property and meet the setback requirements of North Charleston. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if a portion of said could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that a portion of the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 600 square feet of land to Charles T. and Lois J. Cheers was executed on April 17, 2006, in consideration of \$3,900.00.

9. File 37.371 /Road S-99 / Oconee County / Third District

During construction of improvements on Road S-99, under File 37.371 in Oconee County, near the City of Seneca, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-99, by Deed to Right of Way from C. R. and T. N. Bruce dated March 29, 1956.

A request was received from DEA Busbee asking the Department to reduce a 50' x 50' triangle to a 25'x25' triangle in order to clear an encroachment. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.02 of an acre of land to William E. and Sandra G. McAlister was executed on April 21, 2006, in consideration of \$1,000.00.

10. File MSC 11.11.1, 11.5 and 11.7 / Road S-48 / Union County / Fourth District

During construction of a maintenance facility in the City of Union in Union County, the Department acquired property from W.W. Alman, as Administrator of the Estate of Rufus Eubanks, by Title to Real Estate dated September 22, 1969; from Dorothy H. Thomson, Individually and as Attorney-in-Fact for John Herndon Thomson by Title to Real Estate dated May 14, 1969; from J.D. Arthur and H. M. Arthur by Title to Real Estate dated July 7, 1928; from Harry M. Arthur by Title to Real Estate dated July 7, 1928; from Blanche T. Kennedy, Catherine H. Thomson, John H. Thomson and Addie H. Thomson by Title to Real Estate dated April 25, 1938; and from Blanch T. Kennedy and Catherine H. Thomson by Title to Real Estate dated September 22, 1952.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate its surplus property the old Union MSC 11 was declared surplus to the Department needs. An appraisal was ordered and sent to the South Carolina Budget and Control Board (SCB & CB) for approval. The appraisal was approved and permission was given to sell the property. The Grantee offered the highest acceptable offer above the appraised value. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 5.294 acres of land to Union Industrial Services, Inc. was executed on February 17, 2006, in consideration of \$145,000.00.

EXTENSION OF BITUMINOUS RESURFACING CONTRACT

TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL RESURFACING WORK

It is recommended that the Commission approve the action of the Department in extending an existing bituminous retreatment contract to include additional resurfacing work as follows:

ANDERSON COUNTY: (Commissioner Marion P. Carnell)

Contract of F & R Asphalt, Inc. - File No. 4.7205.01 - extended to include full depth patching (File No. 37.7205.01) on S-1150 (Simms School Road) from the Pickens County line to the intersection with SC 88 for 0.19 mile.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 19,808.38

This extension was authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractor involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

EXTENSION OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

It is recommended that the Commission approve the action of the Department in extending existing construction contracts to include additional work as follows:

GREENVILLE COUNTY: (Commissioner F. Hugh Atkins)

Contract of S & S Construction, Inc. of Anderson – File 23.210B – extended to include an additional section of Project FAP STP-SA23(005) (File No. 23.210B) consisting of resurfacing on S-50.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 14,156.25

HORRY COUNTY: (Commissioner Robert Harrell, Sr.)

Contract of Southern Asphalt, Inc. - File No. 26.2005 - extended to include an additional section of State Project SMP-SIMP (File No. 26.2005) consisting of resurfacing of turning lanes on S-57 at North Myrtle Beach Primary School.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 64,122.86

RICHLAND COUNTY: (Commissioner John N. Hardee)

Contract of Reynolds Fence & Guardrail, Inc. - File No. 40.253B - extended to include an additional section of Project SIB-SB40(001) (File No. 40.253B) consisting of the installation of median cable barrier on I-20 at I-77.

Estimated Cost of Extension \$ 46,776.00

These extensions were authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractors involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

Removal of Roads From State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval for the removal of certain sections of secondary roads from the State Highway Secondary System. These sections of roads may be removed for one of the following reasons:

1. Abandonment of Relocated Section of Highway
2. Deletions and Removal of Roads from State Secondary System - Roads may be deleted and removed from secondary system by exchanging for equal or less mileage or roads, which have a higher traffic importance. Ownership reverts to local government having jurisdiction (city or county). Approval of deletion or removal by local government is not required.
3. Abandonment of Right-of-way - Right-of-way may be abandoned if it is determined that the right-of-way is not required for right-of-way proposes or if the right-of-way is not needed for Department purposes.
4. Court Order

Correction of Description of State Highways

The Department recommends Commission approval of the correction of the description of sections of State Highway previously added to the State Highway System. The description of roads currently in the State Highway Secondary System may be changed for relocation purposes, to revise the description of the termini to show what was actually constructed by contract, county line changes, or a change in the secondary road number.

Additions to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval to add sections of road to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may add roads to the State Highway Secondary System by request of the County Transportation Committees contingent on mileage being available under the current mileage cap. Roads may be added to the State Secondary System by the construction of a new roadway, accepting existing county/city roads into our Secondary System by the swap method, or by county line changes. Roads added to the State Highway System must be constructed to Department standards or reviewed for compliance with Department standards.

Rescind Action Adding Roads to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends the Commission rescind its previous actions adding roads to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may rescind action on roads, which have not been constructed and formally accepted into the State Highway Secondary System. Roads may be rescinded due to right-of-way being unavailable, problems arising during construction, or funding issues.

Transfer of Road between Secondary and Primary Systems

The Department recommends Commission approval to transfer sections of road from the Secondary System to the Primary System, or vice versa. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 57-5-50 of the Code-of-Laws of South Carolina, 1976, the Commission may transfer any route or section of route from the state highway secondary system to the state highway primary system, or vice versa, when, in its judgment, such transfer is advisable to better serve the traveling public.

Detailed information concerning each of these requests is attached.
