Re: Informal Resolution / Complaint

Good evening / Good morning however may you receive this ^{sr}/or madam

As listed above my name is Stanley L. Moultrie. I am an prisoner incarcerated at Lee Correctional Institution. The purpose of this "informal resolution complaint" is specifically to permit state official the opportunity to resolve this controversy internally before it becomes a federal issue.

The facts here are several issues but very broad and clear. To begin with I am a mentally ill prisoner diagnosed with paranoid schizophrenia and various symptoms linked to depression and psychosis. The problem here is that state prison officials are retaliating on me and continuously keep violating my constitutional right "Blatantly" as if they want war with me. I am I wrong for exercising my rights?

In March or April 2014 I filed a federal lawsuit against the South Carolina Department of Correction. Both the Governor Hays and the S.C. Attorney General were among more than thirty officials named in this complaint. Case NO.: 9:14-cv-1690-DCN-BM. Even then, many of the defendant still showed no respect for the law. Prior to the summary judgement in March 2015 an prisoner stole a punch off on me for no reason, while another inmate stated that if I didn't leave the dorm that gang members would jump me. When the incident occurred in the Darlington Unit on Lee Correctional Institution, seconds before I was assaulted the officers walked out the Unit... which is the first reason why I believe several prison officials plotted and scheme the whole incident to destroy my effort in making summary judgement in the above case. Secondly, The R.I.T.U. Protective Custody Unit is the punitive segregated Unit where I have been housed for 9 months with no charges. Here, inmates are limited and restricted from having access to law books and case research. Books are restricted whether reading or law from the library. Since I been I have been denied since I've been here two prisoners have died in this administrative lock-up. One prisoner died of a drug overdose while the second committed suicide on November, 18 2015. Me and other prisoner included, haven't had outdoor recreation in 9 months.

Inmates are cutting themselves and attempting suicide at an alarming rate. Some are eating feces others are smearing it over the wall. Presently my cell hasn't been cleaned up or given cleaning supplies in over three months. I can't even get a book to read from the library. Ps 2 of 2

Furthermore, I have no light in my cell R.H.U #81 North side B and it have been this way for 9 months. Additionally, I have asked prison officials to take me off protective custody. Sgt General counsel Mr. Crooks vented in a report there was evidence for me to remain on protective custody other than my request. When the incident occurred back in March 2015 I told Cpt. Richardson that I needed to move to another dorm and he then stated no and placed me on protective custody. How I know the Lee Correction Administrative Staff had something to do with the incident is because the inmate named Pedro or "dro" who punched me with my back turn was stab in the face a month later after a knife fight with another inmate. By policy both inmates were supposed to be detained — they both were stabbed. However, Pedro never came to lock-up because prison officials felt like this would give me a reason to come back to the general population since they knew Pedro was responsible for guising together a plot to get me off the prison yard. They made me believe gang members as Bloods, CRIP, and etc had something to do with it. The whole incident was a plot. Gang member had nothing to do with this, Lee Correction prison officials did. In fact, when Pedro got stab in his face no one even help him as far as his affiliation to the 58 percenters.

Most importantly, I'm being denied due process and the right to be free from solitary confinement. I have been in this cell 9 months with no recreation 24 hours a day with barely a book to read. I was told 9 months ago I was going to be transferred. I am not given the opportunity to call my family regularly. I may have made one call. But my family members have continuously call asking why I'm being treated like this. My liberty interest is being violated where state law and regulation state I have the right to be free from administrative segregation. Evenmore, Per policy classification is to do a review every 30 days after the first 60 days. This have created an atypical hardship for me. See Walt v. McDonnell 418 U.S. 539, 558 (1974)

I have been in this cell 9 months / 24 hour ~~and~~ a day. Please tell these prison officials to let me return back to general population and transfer me. I haven't had a inmate disciplinary charge conviction in 22 months. Why I'm I being punished? Please help.
