Hall has recently relinquished over 80 felines due to her decision to get out of the "Cat Rescue" business. She informed me that she is drafting a letter to the Attorney General in order to relinquish her 501-b tax exempt non-profit status. She currently has numerous animals, however she considers them all her own pets: 10 "show" quality bunnies, 9 dogs, and 13-18 cats. Hall reports that she does not intend to house any more animals, for she wants to keep the animals to a more manageable number. All animals appeared to be well fed, however there were a few with breed specific health issues: deaf 18 year old min pin dog, and two cats with allergy related issues. The dogs generally had free roam of the fenced in outdoor area. CONTINUED.</p>

One section of this structure was very clean and recently remodeled. I did not detect any repulsive odors, and the cages appeared to be clean. There is a fenced in area adjacent to this structure for the bunnies to play outside. This area had a lot of loose items that had been moved out of the garage during remodeling. Hall assured me that the area would be cleaner when I return for a follow up visit the end of March. Hall informed me that most of her animals are provided with care from Northwoods Vet, and she would be able to produce records as needed for my next visit.

Hall has been working diligently on reducing the numbers of animals at her residence, and she has improved the living conditions for her pets. A follow up will be completed. END OF REPORT.

On the above date, I (Deputy Poirier) responded to the incident location in regards to a follow up. Hall appeared surprised to see me, however I did remind her that the visit had been scheduled. There was no change in the amount of animals that she had at her residence. The outdoor area had been noticeably cleaned since our first visit, however the indoor space of the detached garage was the same. Hall indicated that her "contractor" was usually only available to assist her on the weekends. I advised her that I would be back on March 30, 2012 to inspect the premises (some areas needed to be cleaned of cat urine), and the conditions of the indoor area. I also advised Hall that I would need to see veterinary records on two cats that were noticeably ill. Hall informed me that she was dropping both cats off at College Park Veterinary Hospital after my visit. She was advised that I would like to see the 9 cats that she had caged roaming freely, for the cages appeared that they needed to be cleaned. There were two indoor cats roaming in the garage, and two feral cats outdoors (Hall stated that she would be getting them spayed/neutered). All animals had clean water and plenty of food available. Hall stated that she still had her 501-b status in case donations come in, however she was no longer taking any more animals. A Follow up will be completed.

The receipt was from 3/16/12 and it indicates that cat "Fisher" was administered Batrol for an inner ear infection. This was the cat that Hall reported had started wobbling around with balance issues on 3/14/12. There was also antibiotics administered to cat "Venus" in regards to an eye infection. All animals appeared to be in satisfactory conditions, and being appropriately cared for in Hall's residence.
