Oct. 9 - 10:30 a.m. - All can re-enter at 5 p.m. as CEMA moves to Phase 4 Ops

All can return at 5 p.m. today, Oct. 9. City officials urge residents to be prepared to have no electricity/water, and to be aware of downed trees and power lines. They recommend waiting until Monday to enter the county. Only residents will be allowed onto Tybee Island at this time. Visitors from outside the county should avoid entering the area until further notice, in order to give residents and businesses time to recover.
