- Current closures: 51 (down 91%)
 - 27 roads
 - 24 bridges
- 26 of the 51 road closures are related to dam failures from the flood.
- Since December 22nd an additional 76 roads closed due flooding.
 - 71 have reopened
 - 3 more are projected to reopen by end of January.
- 221 bridges were impacted by the flood waters.
 - 25 require full replacement as a result of the flood.
