As I said yesterday I am having a difficult time getting the CIO mainframe billing charges for September corrected. This bill covers the August 1st to 31st period when we no longer had responsibility for charges on the "B" box but they appeared on our Sept. bill. There were also charges from the other mainframe (the "A" box) that we were receiving and should not have been billed to DMV. I suggest that until these issues are resolved the bill to CIO should not be paid. We will continue to work with CIO and DPS to correct the current bill and future billing procedures. I'll keep you up to date and in the loop on anything that goes on. Please let me know if you have question or need additional information about this.
