Beginning Beekeeping

Greenville Co.—Beginning Feb. 10, the Greenville Co. Extension office will offer introductory beekeeping classes. The classes will meet for six consecutive Tuesday evenings until March 16. Steve Genta, S.C. Certified Journeyman Beekeeper, will teach the classes, which will be held from 6 - 8 p.m. Topics will include honeybee management, equipment, diseases, pests and honey. York Co.—York County's Beginning Beekeeping class will begin on Tuesday, Feb. 1 and will be held each Tuesday from 7-8:30 p.m. until March 28. The classes will be held at the Clemson Extension Office in the Agricultural Building, 6 Congress St., in York. A hands-on field day will follow the course. Topics will include beekeeping equipment, the bee family, frame building, handling queens and more. Cost is \$20, which should be sent to York County Beekeepers Association, P.O. New scholarship to be awarded

This year, one lucky agriculture student will get a \$250 boost for college from the S.C. Meat Goat Association.

This is the first year the SCMGA will award the scholarship, which was initiated to provide scholarship assistance to young people who have farm families or are from farm-oriented backgrounds. The student must pursue a higher education in agriculture or agriculture-related fields and must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.3 on a 4.0 scale.

Members of the association hope the scholarship recipient will follow the goals of the association in educating the general public about the roles and uses of meat goats in American agriculture.

The scholarship will be awarded annually to a high school senior or higher. Recipients will be selected by a committee designated by the SCMGA Board of Directors in accordance with guidelines developed by the Board of Directors. The recipient must be or have a family member who is a member of the SCMGA. Any seniors showing 4-H or FFA goats this year would qualify. Master Tree Farmer classes to be held across the state

Master Tree Farmer 2000, a forestry class offered by the Greenville County Extension office, will begin on Feb. 1.

The program will be broadcast by satellite to 13 sites across the state for seven consecutive Tuesday evenings until March 14. The broadcasts will be held from 7-10 p.m. on those Tuesday nights.

Forestry terms and concepts will be discussed, as well as forestry as an investment, taxation and estate planning, pine management, hardwood management, harvesting and marketing, wildlife management, forestry services and field tours.

The course will be conducted in Aiken, Charleston, Chesterfield, Clemson, Columbia, Darlington, Dillon, Georgetown, Greenville, Greenwood, Lancaster, Union and Walterboro. Each location will have a program coordinator and an area forester. The live class will take place in Clemson and be broadcast to the other sites. Commissioner's Column

Ag keeps on truckin'

Ashley Rawl knows that without their fleet of 12 trucks, Walter P. Rawl & Sons Farms couldn't keep all their customers. That's because when you are selling collards, mustard greens and other fresh vegetables to retailers from Miami to Pennsylvania, getting your product to its destination on time is a must. Rawl's customers want their greens to be fresh, and for him, transfer trucks are the best way to transport them.

"We feel that it's very important for us to have our trucks, because our products are perishable," Ashley said.

Without trucks, Ashley would have no practical way of distributing his products to retailers—if he wanted them to arrive fresh. He usually uses the company's own fleet of trucks, but when necessary, he hires transport companies, as do many other farms and agribusinesses. Because of trucks, both large and small, South Carolinians can transport their goods within 24 hours to Florida, Canada and cities as far west as the Mississippi.

I have personally been involved in the trucking business since 1958, when I first received a "Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity," the license then required to operate trucks. I was officially licensed to transport my commodities and other farmers' commodities to market. In addition, I have been a member of the S.C. Trucking Association for 41 years.

The S.C. Department of Agriculture also plays a role in the trucking industry. The Consumer Services Division works closely with the S.C. Department of Transportation to calibrate highway weighing scales for trucks. Our Metrology Laboratory houses the state standards for mass, length and volume, which are used to check the accuracy of the equipment used by weights and measures officials. Accurate calculations are essential when farmers and truckers are paid based on weight or volume.

Statistics show the strong correlation between ag and trucking. The trucking industry is enormous. Transfer trucks moved an average of 772,556 TONS of freight into and out of South Carolina each day in 1998, according to the S.C. Trucking Association. On any given day, you can bet that 10 percent of the transfer trucks you see on the road are carrying agricultural products. Indeed, trucks supply produce and goods to more than 1,500 agricultural businesses in the state.

Let's take a look at how the entire trucking industry affects the state. One out of every 11 workers was employed in trucking-related occupations at private and for-hire motor carriers in 1997. The total annual payroll for the trucking industry in South Carolina was \$3.8 billion, and the average annual wage paid to trucking industry workers was \$28,839. Now, imagine losing 10 percent of those wages. I think it's safe to say that if our state's agricultural community were to diminish, the trucking industry would be largely affected. On the same note, without the trucking industry, agriculture and agribusiness would be severely limited.

I also pay close attention to truck safety, an important issue to anyone on the road. In our state, truck safety inspections are conducted under the Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program. In 1998, 33,425 of these inspections were conducted, an increase of 82 percent since 1992. That means that trucks on the road today are much safer than they were ten years ago.

Good news for the trucking industry is good news for agriculture. Anyone with an interest in agriculture should also pay close attention to industries that support and aid agriculture. Agriculture consists of more than farmers—it's a network of people with various trades and skills that are important to producing our foods and fibers. So I'd like to commend South Carolina's truck drivers and trucking companies for helping us to help others get supper on the table—on time! With a mouth full of food I can still say, "Thank you truckers!"

Turnip Casserole

Ingredients: 8 med. turnips, peeled & cut into 2"x1/2" strips, 1/2 cup finely chopped celery, 2 lg. carrots, scraped & cut into 2"x1/2" strips, 1/4 cup chopped onion, 1 cup English peas, 1 (4oz.) jar chopped pimento, 1 (10 3/4 oz.) can cream of mushroom soup, 1 cup sour cream, 1/2 teaspoon dried basil, 1/2 cup herb-seasoned stuffing mix, 1/4 cup melted margarine.

Directions: Place first 4 ingredients in a large pot, cover with water and cook 5-8 min. or until vegetables are tender. Drain well. Stir in peas and pimento. Set aside while combining other ingredients. Stir soup, sour cream and basil together, add vegetable mixture. Pour into a well-greased 9" square casserole dish. Combine stuffing and butter. Spread over top of casserole. Bake at 350° for 30 min. Yields 8 servings.
