M I N U T E S

PRESENT:

Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Councilman Hooper gave the invocation.

Mr. Poore advised Council that several members of the County Stockade were present to discuss the closing of the Stockade. Mr. Poore stated that last Wednesday night, Mr. Rhodes, Mr. Hooper and Mr. Kinley met with the attorney, Bob Lusk, regarding the closing of the Stockade. Mr. Poore asked County Council to go into executive session to discuss the matter. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council decided to move on to the business as listed on the agenda.

On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the July 21, July 22, and July 24, 1981 as mailed.

Mr. Bill Watkins representing Baxter/Kelly presented County Council with Resolution #128 requesting permission to purchase a 30,980 square foot part of leased property for the sum of \$4,260. On the motion of Mr. Bratcher, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to release the property approving Resolution #128.

Mr. Bill Gaston, Chairman of the Election Commission asked Council for \$7,770.00 of additional funds for operation of the November 10th election. He also explained the different voting systems in SC and asked Council to consider going to a voting recorder. He explained the need to consolidate and split certain precincts and the possibility of hiring a permanent employee. Council received Mr. Gaston's remarks as information.

Mr. Prue Gilreath asked Council to consider certain proposals to explore in expanding County Council. 1. Create a seven member Council by creating seven county council districts. 2. Create a nine member council by creating nine county council districts. 3. Adjust the present five council districts to meet requirements of federal regulations and then create seat one and seat two in each district. 4. Create a nine member council with seven council districts and two-at-large council seats. Ms. Beatrice Thompson asked Council to consider black representation if Council considers expanding. Council received as information.

Mr. David Crenshaw asked Council to approve a blanket bond for deputy sheriffs from Citizens Insurance Agency, Inc. for an annual premium of \$267.58. On the motion of Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to approve the blanket bond.

Mr. Rhodes presented first reading of Ordinance #69 (Rules and Regulations of purchases after May 15). On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council

voted 4 in favor and 1 against to approve on first reading Ordinance #69. Mr. Bratcher voted against the motion.

At the request of Mr. Rhodes, Mr. Kinley, Mr. Hooper and Mr. Wright their list of roads in dire need of repair is hereby made a part of the minutes. Mr. Poore stated the roads were being repaired as fast as possible.

Mr. Hooper presented Ordinance #68 (Sewer System or Systems) for third and final reading. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve on third reading.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to transfer \$1,500 from Code 910 (Contingency Fund) to the Sheriff's budget for training.

Mr. Hooper presented first reading of Ordinance #70 (Board for Mentally Retarded & Developmentally Disabled). On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve on first reading.

Mr. Kinley presented a notice to be published in the Greenville News, Anderson Independent, Williamston Journal, Belton News, & Honea Path Chronicle regarding delinquent taxes giving notice that all delinquent tax payers have 30 days from the date of notice to pay all delinquent taxes. After a long discussion, Council was ready to vote. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted 3 in favor and 2 against the motion. Mr. Wright and Mr. Bratcher voted against the motion. Motion passed by majority vote. County Council directed the Clerk to put the notice in the newspapers, and to paid from out of the Contingency Fund (Code 910.79.)

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council adjourned at 10:37 a.m.

Mr. Poore stated that he would fix all roads requested as priority as soon as possible and as long as money is available.

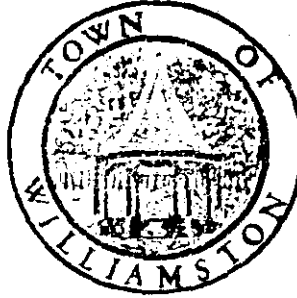
