Pursuant to the state open records law S.C. Code Ann. Secs. 30-4-10 to 30-4-165, I write to request access to and a copy of a list of:

- school districts
- cities
- individual schools
- any other local entity

in your state under state takeover and/or whose finances are currently under state control/receivership or were in control/receivership in the past six years.

Please provide:

- 1) the name of each district/city/school/agency in your state.
- 2) the date the takeover/receivership began.
- 3) the date the takeover/receivership ended, if it ended.

Please provide in an electronic format in order to avoid delays and cost. If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address. If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address.

If there are any fees associated with filling this request, please contact us so we can make arrangements.

As provided by the open records law, I will expect your response within fifteen (15) working days. See S.C. Code Ann. Sec. 30-4-30(c).

If you choose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. Also, please provide all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material.

I would note that willful violation of the open records law is a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to \$100 or imprisonment for up to 30 days. See S.C. Code Ann. Sec. 30-4-110. Court costs and reasonable attorney fees may also be awarded. See Sec. 30-4-100.
