That's an increase of \$1,422,827,047,452.46 over last year's fiscal year close. Our Congress took on nearly \$1.5 trillion of debt over the past year!

**Remember the ancient adage "All debt must be paid; either by the borrower or the lender?"**

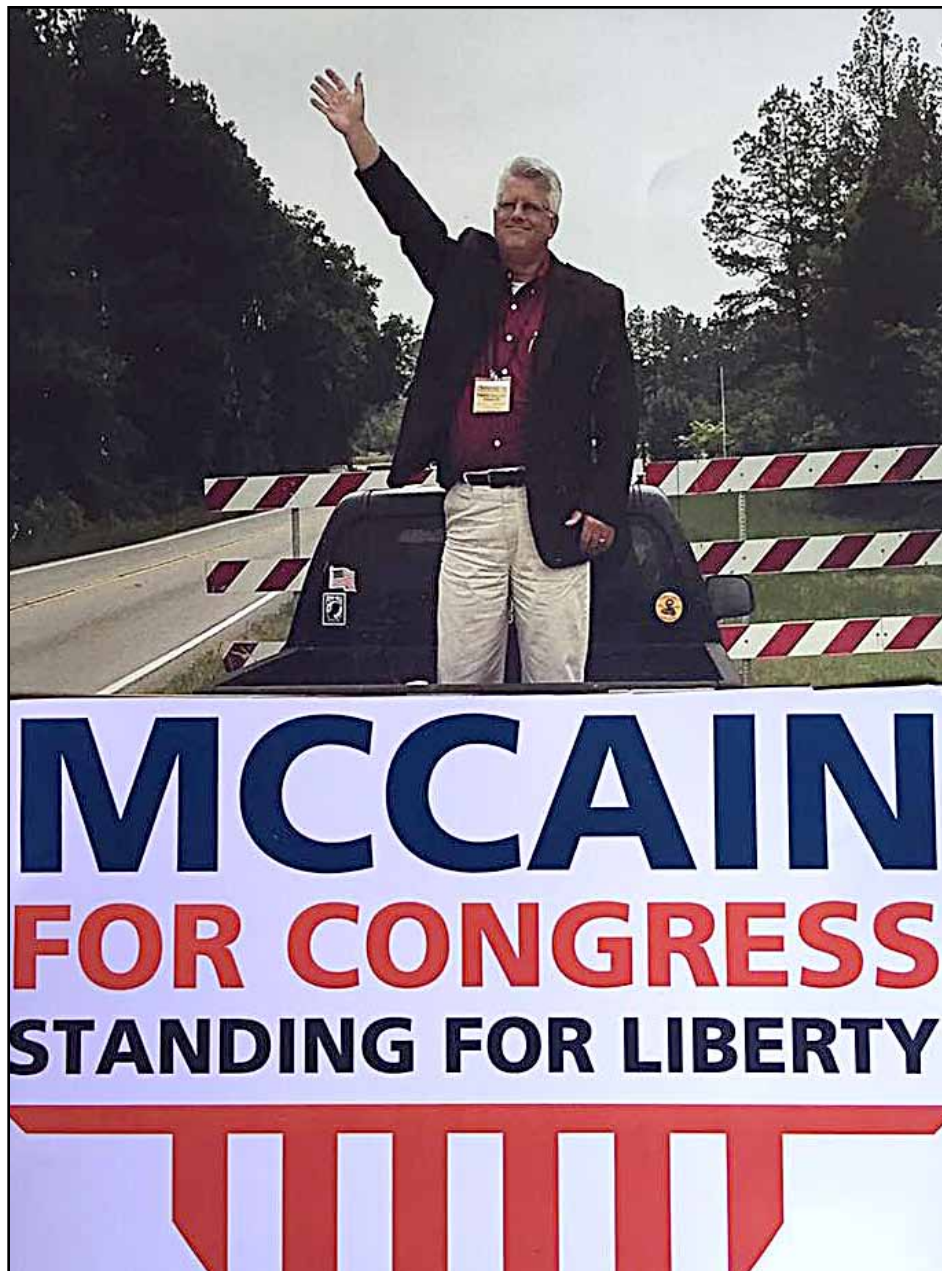
The dilemma is: What actually happens when a nation cannot meet their debt obligations?

I know some people believe we need an annual vehicle tax to pay for the roads. Here is my annual vehicle tax bill! Not one penny goes to roads! Our roads are paid for from the 35 cents per gallon fuel tax that we pay when we buy fuel: 16.75 cents per gallon goes to South Carolina and 18.4 cents per gallon goes to the Federal government. Maybe South Carolina should keep the entire 35 cents as our Interstates are pocked with pot holes too.

We have a right to travel and should not be forced to register our vehicles and pay an annual vehicle tax. Only privileges should be registered and taxed, not rights!!

All commercial vehicles are supposed to be registered because they are using public roads for commercial reason. Those of us who don't make money using public roads are not supposed to register our vehicles and pay a registration tax. We have a right to use the roads, commercial drivers don't.

We, the travelers of our highways, are paying for our roads at the gas pump, but government is not repairing!!

Republicans control the House and the Senate and AGAIN failed to pass a budget appropriation bill. Congress will once again pass a "continuing resolution" to keep giving President Obama everything he wants and yield an annual deficit of \$600 billion.

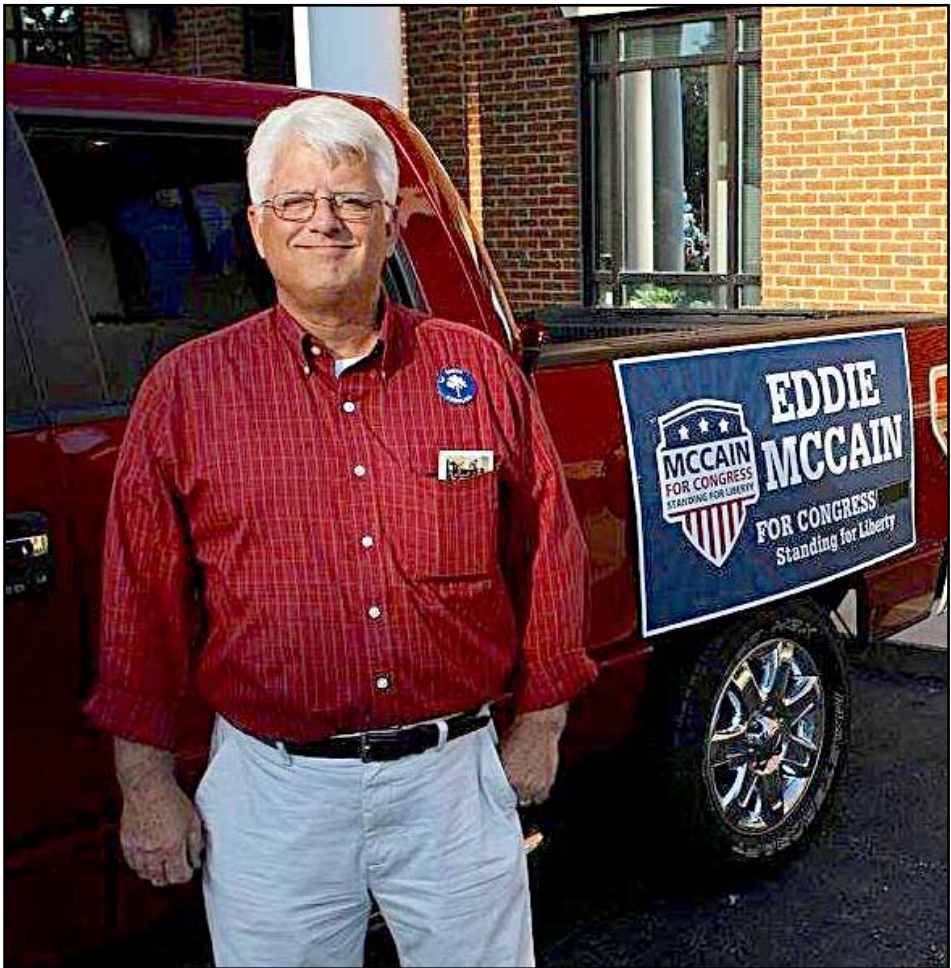
We need a Balanced Budget Amendment. The best way to get our Congress to balance the budget is to get them to repeal the 16th and 17th Amendments!

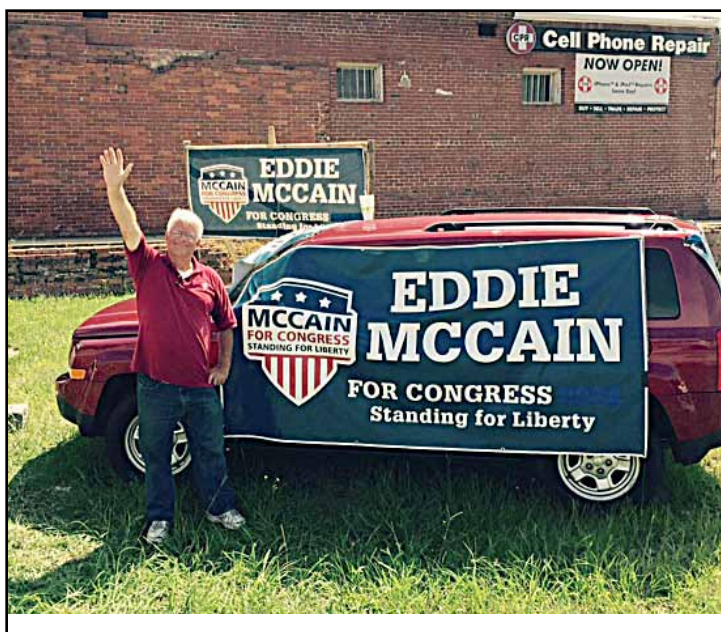

## Eddie McCain for Congress Contract With the Citizens of South Carolina Second Congressional District

To the citizens of the South Carolina Second Congressional District, I, Eddie McCain, candidate for Congress for the South Carolina Second Congressional District, hereby contract myself to you for the following upon your election of me to represent our district in the House of Representatives.
