Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Councilman David Hooper gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the May 11, 1981 meeting as mailed.

Mr. Kinley presented Ordinance #65 (Maintenance of County Roads) for third and final reading. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council amended the ordinance to include: "Anyone violating this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor or \$100 fine or 30 days in Jail." The Ordinance passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Poore advised Council that he and the County Attorney had to sign a grant agreement to finalize the closing of the grant which was for the re-surfacing of the run-way completed last year at the Anderson Airport.

Mr. Poore stated that he had an easement on the Mall Road through the County property to be signed. After a discussion, Council agreed to include the stipulation that the easement is invalid unless work has begun before July, 1985. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve the easement with this provision.

Mr. Trey Senn presented a survey of public mass transportation in Anderson done on behalf of the S.C. Appalachian Council of Governments. He stated that Anderson County has basically two kinds: (1) Duke Power Transportation System (Bus), (2) several public agencies that provides transportation to retarded agencies and others. Mr. Senn asked for Council's endorsement on the synopsis. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve the survey.

Mr. Kinley invited everyone to the Elks Lodge on Saturday, May 23, 1981 at 2:00 for Flag Day ceremony.

On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 7:30 p.m.
